The three cells on the lower portion of the table give the results of an annual evaluation conducted by the Center for Research in Education Policy (CREP), University of Memphis.

**Cell # 1 – STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT:** Shows the provider's effectiveness in raising student achievement on the state tests in reading, language arts, and mathematics. Results may be listed as follows:

- a. **Insufficient data:** There was not enough information available that would indicate effectiveness. This could mean that the provider tutored small numbers of students or achievement test scores were not available for students.
- b. **Above Standards:** There is evidence that tutored students are making substantive achievement gains.
- b. **Acceptable:** There is evidence that tutored students are making achievement gains.
- c. **Marginal Quality:** There is some evidence that some tutored students are making achievement gains.
- d. **Below Standards in Student Achievement:** Students have not shown gains after tutoring. Results are statistically significant and favor non-SES students.
