

## TOWN MEETING NOTICE

A Town Hall meeting will be held on Tuesday October 27, 2009 at the Medina City Hall, 112 North Main Street, Medina. The meeting will be held from 5 to 7 PM. CDT. The topic of discussion will be the issuance of a proposed construction permit (Division identification number: 27-0217-01/62934) of a crematory and associated equipment used to incinerate deceased human remains. The applicant is Medina Funeral Home & Cremation Service located on 302 West Church Street, Medina, TN 38355. Liquid Propane would be used for fuel. An afterburner, secondary chamber temperature monitor and opacity monitor would be used for pollution control. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source

The applicant has undergone the 30 day public notice for a proposed installation in accordance with 1200-3-9-.01(1)(h) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations, which requires a public notification (published August 18, 2009) and a 30-day public comment period. Written comments were received from the public and mailed to the Division of Air Pollution Control. In order to address these concerns, a town hall meeting has been scheduled. This meeting is not a legal requirement of the Division of Air Pollution Control but will provide an opportunity for participation and discussion by interested parties regarding this permit application. The permit application and technical information regarding cremation will also be available for examination at the meeting.

This meeting is being held for the purpose of discussing the proposed permit, becoming familiar with the operation of cremation, informing those present what state air pollution control requirements are, and providing what experience the Division of Air Pollution Control has had regarding previously permitted Tennessee crematories. The permit application, details about the incinerator, and information regarding the technical aspects of cremation as it relates to air pollution control will be able to be reviewed. Any comments written or verbal will be considered at this meeting if received no later than 7 PM CDT October 27, 2009.
