

New Source Review newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications, July 23, 2009. The following public notices have been published in the newspapers listed below each advertisement. These newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications were published on one of the following dates: July 20, July 21, July 22, or July 23, 2009. Public notices are generally published every two weeks. The previous publication of public notices was July 9, 2009.

### PUBLIC NOTICE

The Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) has received requests for construction and/or modification of air contaminant sources as noted below. The proposed construction and/or modification is subject to part 1200-3-9-.01(1)(h) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations, which requires a public notification and 30-day public comment period. Interested parties may express their comments and concerns in writing to Mr. Barry R. Stephens, Director, Division of Air Pollution Control, 9<sup>th</sup> Floor, L & C Annex, 401 Church Street, Nashville, Tennessee 37243-1531 within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice. Questions concerning a source may be addressed to the assigned Division personnel at the same address or by calling 615-532-0554.

Individuals with disabilities who wish to participate should contact the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation to discuss any auxiliary aids or services needed to facilitate such participation. Such contact may be in person, by writing, telephone, or other means, and should be made no less than ten days prior to the end of the public comment period to allow time to provide such aid or services. The applicant is Northwest Tennessee Crematory with a mailing address of P.O. Box 190, Huntingdon, TN 38344. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 09-0118-01/62885) for construction of a Crematory located at 650 High St, Huntingdon, TN 38344. This proposed operation would consist of a crematory and associated equipment used to incinerate human remains. Natural gas would be used for fuel. An afterburner and secondary chamber temperature monitor would be used for pollution control. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Ms. Sarosh Kaiser is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is Claysville Quarry with a mailing address of 3458 Old Highway 70, Crossville, TN 38572. They seek to obtain air contaminant permits for construction of a Rock Crushing Operation located at the same address listed above. Multiply operations are as follows:

- (1) Rock Crushing Operation (Division identification number: 18-0130-01/62421). This existing operation consists of crushed rock, stone stockpiles, portable powered screening equipment, conveyors and associated equipment used to crush stone. Wet suppression is used for pollution control. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Mr. W. Collins is the assigned Division person.
- (2) Generators (Division identification number: 18-0130-02/62805). This existing operation consists of two (2) portable diesel-fired engines and associated equipment used to produce power. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Mr. W. Collins is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is Green Plains Renewable Energy, LLC with a mailing address of P.O. Box 95, Obion, TN 38240. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 66-0123-14/62897) for construction of two Temporary Steam Generators at 2098 McDonald Road, approximately three (3) miles NE of the City of Obion. This proposed operation would consist of two natural gas fired boilers and associated equipment used to generate process steam. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. J. Fuss is the assigned Division person.
