

PUBLIC NOTICE

Dura Automotive Systems has applied to the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Division (TAPCD) for a [federally enforceable state operating permit \(FESOP\)](#) to opt-out of being subject to the provisions of paragraph 1200-3-9-.02(11) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations (also frequently referred to as Title V regulations). Dura Automotive Systems has voluntarily agreed to be bound by a permit that limits their potential to emit Volatile Organic Chemicals (VOCs), such that they are below the applicability threshold of 100 tons per year. Additionally they have voluntarily agreed to be bound by a permit that limits their potential to emit Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs) below the applicability threshold of 10 tons per year for any single HAP and 25 tons per year for all combined HAPs. Dura Automotive Systems has agreed to use record keeping methods to prove that they are abiding by more restrictive emission limits. However, it should be noted that this facility has a current state operating permit.

The applicant is Dura Automotive Systems with a mailing address of 2200 Helton Drive, Lawrenceburg, TN 38464. They seek to obtain a FESOP, also known as a conditional major permit, for their entire clay processing facility.

The TAPCD has made the determination that this facility can be approved to opt-out of being subject to Title V regulations if certain conditions are met. Interested parties are invited to review these materials and comment. In addition, a public hearing may be requested at which written or oral presentations may be made. To be considered, written comments or requests for a public hearing must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice and should be addressed to Mr. Barry R.
