

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) has received a request for construction permit as noted below. The proposed permit modification is subject to part 1200-3-9-.01(1)(h) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations, which requires a public notification and 30-day public comment period. Interested parties may express their comments and concerns in writing to Mr. Barry R. Stephens, Director, Division of Air Pollution Control, 9th Floor, L & C Annex, 401 Church Street, Nashville, Tennessee 37243-1531 within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice. Questions concerning a source may be addressed to the assigned Division personnel at the same address or by calling 615-532-0554.

The applicant is East Tennessee Natural Gas, LLC (ETNG) – Station 3209 with a site address of 58 Ray Road, Winchester, TN. They seek to obtain an modified air contaminant permit (Division identification number 26-0080-01,03/62759) for two natural gas fired turbine and one emergency generator for their natural gas transmission compressor station. The company wants to opt out of being subject to the provisions of paragraph 1200-3-9-.02(11) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations by reducing their emissions. The company has agreed to be bound by a permit that limits their potential to emit for Carbon Monoxide (CO), single hazardous air pollutant (HAP) and combined HAPs, such that they are below the applicability thresholds of 100.0 tons, 10 tons and 25 tons per year, respectively. There would be no physical construction and regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. M. Ahmed is the assigned Division person.

Individuals with disabilities who wish to participate should contact the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation to discuss any auxiliary aids or services needed to facilitate such participation. Such contact may be in person, by writing, telephone, or other means, and should be made no less than ten days prior to the end of the thirty (30) day public comment period to allow time to provide such aid or service.
