

New Source Review newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications, July 9, 2009. The following public notices have been published in the newspapers listed below each advertisement. These newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications were published on one of the following dates: July 7, July 8, or July 9, 2009. Public notices are generally published every two weeks. The previous publication of public notices was June 25, 2009.

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) has received requests for construction and/or modification of air contaminant sources as noted below. The proposed construction and/or modification is subject to part 1200-3-9-.01(1)(h) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations, which requires a public notification and 30-day public comment period. Interested parties may express their comments and concerns in writing to Mr. Barry R. Stephens, Director, Division of Air Pollution Control, 9th Floor, L & C Annex, 401 Church Street, Nashville, Tennessee 37243-1531 within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice. Questions concerning a source may be addressed to the assigned Division personnel at the same address or by calling 615-532-0554.

Individuals with disabilities who wish to participate should contact the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation to discuss any auxiliary aids or services needed to facilitate such participation. Such contact may be in person, by writing, telephone, or other means, and should be made no less than ten days prior to the end of the public comment period to allow time to provide such aid or services. The applicant is Avisco, Inc. with a mailing address of 1005 Clarence Larsen, Oak Ridge, TN 37930. They seek to obtain air contaminant permits for air contaminant sources located at 145 Cedar Brook Lane, Kingston, TN 37763 as follows:

(1) Clay Processing Operation (Division identification number: 73-0175-01/62877). This existing operation consists of soil borrow pit activities, such as excavation and storage of native clay, a bentonite storage silo with vent filter, and a pugmill for blending the native clay with bentonite and water. A baghouse is used for pollution control. There would not be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Ms. Hymelia Craig is the assigned Division person.

(2) Diesel power electrical generator (Division identification number: 73-0175-02/62878). This existing operation consists of a diesel power electrical generator used to provide power for a clay processing operation. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would not be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Ms. Hymelia Craig is the assigned Division person.

For the "Roane County News"--published once on or before Thursday, July 9, 2009.

The applicant is Pristine Cleaners with a mailing address of 6220 Belle Rive Drive, Brentwood, TN 37027. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 75-0642-01/62872) for modification of a Dry Cleaning Facility located at 561 Nissan Drive, Smyrna, TN 37167. This existing operation consists of a dry-to-dry perchloroethylene dry cleaning machine. A refrigerated condenser is used for pollution control. The requested modification is to transfer a dry cleaning machine to the facility listed. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Mr. W. Collins is the assigned Division person.

For the Rutherford County "Daily News Journal"--published once on or before Thursday, July 9, 2009.

The applicant is Kroger Fuel Center L-578 with a mailing address of 1600 Ormsby Station Ct., Louisville, KY 40223. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 95-0284-01/62852) for modification of a Gasoline Dispensing Facility located at 401 South Mt. Juliet Road, Mt. Juliet, TN 37122. This existing operation consists of two (2) underground tanks and eight (8) gasoline nozzles. Stage I and Stage II vapor recovery are to be used for gasoline emission control. The proposed modification is for the addition of four (4) gasoline nozzles. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. W. Collins is the assigned Division person.
