

New Source Review newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications, June 11, 2009. The following public notices have been published in the newspapers listed below each advertisement. These newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications were published on one of the following dates: June 9, June 10, or June 11, 2009. Public notices are generally published every two weeks. The previous publication of public notices was May 28, 2009.

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) has received requests for construction and/or modification of air contaminant sources as noted below. The proposed construction and/or modification is subject to part 1200-3-9-.01(1)(h) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations, which requires a public notification and 30-day public comment period. Interested parties may express their comments and concerns in writing to Mr. Barry R. Stephens, Director, Division of Air Pollution Control, 9th Floor, L & C Annex, 401 Church Street, Nashville, Tennessee 37243-1531 within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice. Questions concerning a source may be addressed to the assigned Division personnel at the same address or by calling 615-532-0554.

Individuals with disabilities who wish to participate should contact the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation to discuss any auxiliary aids or services needed to facilitate such participation. Such contact may be in person, by writing, telephone, or other means, and should be made no less than ten days prior to the end of the public comment period to allow time to provide such aid or services. The applicant is Nestaway, LLC with a mailing address of 1373 Rochelle Road, McKenzie, TN 38201. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit for (Division identification number: 09-0083-01/62710) a Fluidized Bed Coating Operation located at the same address. This existing operation consists of a drip primer chamber, fluidized bed coaters, curing ovens, and associated equipment used to produce plastic coated complex wire forms. A wet scrubber is used for pollution control. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Mr. E. King is the assigned Division person.

For the *Carroll County News-Leader* -- published once on or before Thursday, June 11, 2009.

The applicant is McKinney Butcher Shop with a mailing address of 730 Goose Bradley Lane, Butler, Tennessee 37640. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 46-0057-01/62756) for construction of a Butcher Shop Waste Incinerator located at the same address. This proposed operation would consist of a No. 2 fuel oil fired incinerator and associated equipment used to incinerate animal remains. There would be an afterburner for pollution control. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Ms. Hymelia Craig is the assigned Division person.

For Johnson County *Tomahawk* -- published once on or before Thursday, June 11, 2009.

The applicant is Rogers Group, Inc. – Lewisburg Quarry with a mailing address of P.O.Box 25250, Nashville, TN 37202-5250. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 59-0013-03/62797) for construction of a portable diesel generator located at 600 Darnell Mealer Road, Lewisburg, TN 37091. This proposed operation consists of a portable diesel generator for generation of power for the rock crushing plant. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Mr. Abbas Yavari is the assigned Division person.

For the *Marshall County Tribune* -- published once on or before Thursday, June 11, 2009.

The applicant is LoJac Enterprises, Inc. with a mailing address of PO Box 387, Hermitage, TN 37076. They seek to obtain air contaminant permits for construction of an asphalt plant at Joe Dowlen Road, across from Vulcan Quarry in Pleasant View, TN, as follows:

(1) Asphalt plant (Division identification number: 74-0189-01/62775). The proposed operations would consist of an Astec Portable double barrel drum mix asphalt plant and associated equipment used to process asphalt. A high temperature bag house would be used for pollution control. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source.

(2) Diesel Engine (Division identification number: 74-0189-01/62775). This proposed operation would consist of a 1,000 horse power diesel engine and associated equipment used to power the asphalt processing operations. The use of pollution control equipment is not proposed and not required by regulations. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. D. Wright is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is LoJac Enterprises, Inc. with a mailing address of PO Box 387, Hermitage, TN 37076. They seek to obtain air contaminant permits for the modification of an asphalt plant at 324 Rogers Road in Gordonsville, TN, as follows:

(1) Asphalt plant (Division identification number: 80-0043-02/62757). The proposed modification would consist of adding an Astec Portable double barrel drum mix asphalt plant and associated equipment used to process asphalt. A high temperature bag house would be used for pollution control. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source.

(2) Diesel Engine (Division identification number: 80-0043-03/62757). This proposed modification would consist of adding a 1,000 horse power diesel engine and associated equipment used to power the asphalt processing operations. The use of pollution control equipment is not proposed and not required by regulations. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. D. Wright is the assigned Division person.

For the *Smith County Carthage Courier* -- published once on or before Thursday, June 11, 2009.

The applicant is The Robinette Company with a mailing address of P.O. Box 3567, Bristol, TN 37620. They seek to obtain air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 82-0314-01/62828) for modification of printing operation located at 621 Mountain View Road, Piney Flats, TN 37686. This existing operation consists of a flexographic printing press. The requested modification is for addition of three (3) flexographic printing presses. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed for the flexographic printing presses. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Ms. O. Jacobsen is the assigned Division person.
