

PUBLIC NOTICE

Milan Army Ammunition Plant has applied to the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Division (TAPCD) for a [major source operating permit](#) subject to the provisions of paragraph 1200-3-9-.02(11) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations (also frequently referred to as Title V regulations). A major source (Title V) operating permit is required by both the Federal Clean Air Act and the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations.

The applicant is Milan Army Ammunition Plant with a site address of 2280 Tennessee HWY 104 West, Suite 1, Milan, TN. They seek to obtain a major source operating permit for their ammunition components manufacturing and complete final assembly of military ammunition. It should be noted that the company has current operating permits for this facility.

Interested parties are invited to review these materials and comment. In addition, a public hearing may be requested at which written or oral presentations may be made. To be considered, written comments or requests for a public hearing must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice and should be addressed to **Mr. Barry R. Stephens, Director, Air Pollution Control Division, 9th Floor, L & C Annex, 401 Church Street, Nashville, Tennessee 37243-1531**. Questions concerning the source may be addressed to Roy Chuang at the same address or by calling (615)-532-9189. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has agreed to treat this draft permit as a proposed permit and to perform its 45-day review concurrently with the public notice period. A final determination will be made after weighing all relevant comments.
