

PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE

Mantria Industries, LLC has applied to the Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) for construction of a Batch Charcoal Manufacturing Operation to be located South of the intersection of Highway 8 / 111 and Fredonia Road, near the town of Dunlap, Tennessee.

The proposed operation would consist of two (2) 3.5 ton per hour flash carbonization reactors (pressure vessels). A catalytic afterburner, limestone slurry bed, carbon filter, condenser and fabric filter would be used for pollution control. There would be physical construction and regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. Younes Aleali is the assigned Division person.

In response to requests received by the TDAPC, an informational public meeting will be held by TDAPC at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 19, 2009, at the Public Meeting Room located at City Hall, 293 Cedar Street, in Dunlap. This meeting will be held for the purpose of providing information and receiving oral and / or written comments on the proposed project.

TDAPC has made the preliminary determination that this proposed facility can be approved for permit issuance if certain conditions are met.
