

New Source Review newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications, March 19, 2009. The following public notices have been published in the newspapers listed below each advertisement. These newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications were published on one of the following dates: March 17, March 18, March 19, or March 20, 2009. Public notices are generally published every two weeks. The previous publication of public notices was March 5, 2009.

### PUBLIC NOTICE

The Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) has received requests for construction and/or modification of air contaminant sources as noted below. The proposed construction and/or modification is subject to part 1200-3-9-.01(1)(h) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations, which requires a public notification and 30-day public comment period. Interested parties may express their comments and concerns in writing to Mr. Barry R. Stephens, Director, Division of Air Pollution Control, 9<sup>th</sup> Floor, L & C Annex, 401 Church Street, Nashville, Tennessee 37243-1531 within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice. Questions concerning a source may be addressed to the assigned Division personnel at the same address or by calling 615-532-0554.

Individuals with disabilities who wish to participate should contact the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation to discuss any auxiliary aids or services needed to facilitate such participation. Such contact may be in person, by writing, telephone, or other means, and should be made no less than ten days prior to the end of the public comment period to allow time to provide such aid or services. The applicant is Pilot Corporation #112, with a mailing address of 5508 Lonas Road, Knoxville, TN 37909. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 05-0207-01/62679) for a Gasoline Dispensing Facility located at 1907 Marriott Road, Louisville, TN 37777. This existing operation consists of two gasoline storage tanks and associated gasoline dispensing equipment. Stage I gasoline vapor recovery is used for pollution control. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Ms. Hymelia Craig is the assigned Division person.

For the Blount County *Maryville Daily Times* – published once on or before Thursday, April 2, 2009, because rescheduled from Thursday, March 19, 2009.

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The applicant is Sanford L.P. with a mailing address of 3 Sharpie Way, Shelbyville, TN 37355. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 16-0184-01/62541) for installation of a new Ink Manufacturing operation located at 831 Volunteer Parkway, Manchester, TN 37355. This facility's source category does not have a promulgated MACT standard that applies. This proposed operation would consist of dyers, dry materials, storage tanks, and an emergency diesel engine serving as a fire pump engine. Because of the amount and type of pollutants, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. Jim A. Attar is the assigned Division person.

For the Coffee County *Tullahoma News* – published once on or before Thursday, March 19, 2009.

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The applicant is Highland Corporation with a mailing address of P.O. Box 190 Hohenwald, TN 38462. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 22-0145-01/62672) for a Gasoline Dispensing Facility located at 703 Highway 48 South, Dickson, TN 37055. This existing operation consists of two (2) underground tanks and eight (8) gasoline nozzles. A Stage I vapor recovery is used for gasoline emission control. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Mr. W. Collins is the assigned Division person.

For the Dickson County *The Dickson Herald* – published once on or before Thursday, March 19, 2009.

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The applicant is Franklin Industrial Minerals with a mailing address of 9020 Overlook Blvd, Suite 200, Brentwood, Tennessee 37027. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 26-0026-01/62521) for modification of the Mineral Crushing Operation located at 2024 Crownover Road, Sherwood, Tennessee. This proposed modification would consist of an increase in input rate and a change in the method of record keeping. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. J. Swinea is the assigned Division person.

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The applicant is Weigel's #65, with a mailing address of P.O. Box 650, Powell, TN 37849. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 32-0276-01/62674) for modification of an existing Gasoline Dispensing Facility located at 2106 West Andrew Johnson Highway, Morristown, TN 37816. This existing operation consists of two (2) gasoline storage tanks and associated gasoline dispensing equipment. The requested modification is to increase the maximum monthly throughput. Stage I vapor recovery equipment is used for gasoline emission control. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Ms. Hymelia Craig is the assigned Division person.

For the Hamblen County *Citizen Tribune* – published once on Monday, March 30, 2009, because rescheduled from March 19, 2009.

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The applicant is West Tennessee Funeral Associates with a mailing address of 2400 Highway 13 North, Waverly, TN 37165. They seek to obtain air contaminant permit (Division identification number 43-0080-01/62664) for construction of a Human Crematory system to be located at the same address. This proposed operation would consist of a 1.5 MM Btu per hour natural gas-fired Incinerator used to cremate deceased human remains. An afterburner would be used for pollution control. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. Younes Aleali is the assigned Division person.

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The applicant is Pilot Corporation #212, with a mailing address of 5508 Lonas Road, Knoxville, TN 37909. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 53-0120-01/62680) for a Gasoline Dispensing Facility located at 700 East Broadway, Lenoir City, TN 37771. This existing operation consists of two gasoline storage tanks and associated gasoline dispensing equipment. Stage I gasoline vapor recovery is used for pollution control. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Ms. Hymelia Craig is the assigned Division person.

For the Loudon County *News-Herald* – published once on or before Thursday, March 19, 2009.

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The applicant is Johnson Controls Seating Systems, LLC with a mailing address of 2206 Oakland Parkway, Columbia, TN 38401. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 60-0237-01/62002) for one Emergency Diesel Generator Operation located at the same address. This existing diesel fired generator is used as a back-up generator to ensure continuation of the facility operations in the event of electrical power outage. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Ms. Sarosh Kaiser is the assigned Division person.

Loading and Unloading Station located on 2098 McDonald Road, Rives, TN 38253. This existing operation consists of pumps, pipes, valves, and associated equipment used to loadout denatured ethanol and receive gasoline. An industrial flare is used for pollution control. The requested modification is for the addition of another truck loadout station. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants emitted by this source would increase. Mr. J. Fuss is the assigned Division person.

For the Obion County *Union City Daily Messenger* – published once on or before Thursday, March 19, 2009.

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The applicant is Builders Supply Company with a mailing address of 50 Scott Avenue, Cookeville, TN 38501. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 71-0106-02/62656) for modification of a Ready-Mix Concrete Operation located at the same address. This proposed construction would consist of replacing the existing plant with new plant equipment, including silos, weigh batcher and associated equipment used to produce concrete. Fabric filter would be used for pollution control. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. 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#### FIRST APPLICANT:

The applicant is Ishwar Krupa, Inc. with a mailing address of 3251 South Mt. Juliet Road, Mt. Juliet, TN 37122. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 95-0309-01/62660) for construction of a Gasoline Dispensing Facility at, 2300 Nonaville Road, Mt. Juliet, TN 37122. This proposed operation would consist of two (2) underground tanks and four (4) gasoline nozzles. A Stage I and Stage II vapor recovery would be used for gasoline emission control. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. W. Collins is the assigned Division person.

#### SECOND APPLICANT:

They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 95-0308-01/62661) for construction of a Gasoline Dispensing Facility at, 1050 Old Lebanon Dirt Road, Mt. Juliet, TN 37122. This proposed operation would consist of two (2) underground tanks and six (6) gasoline nozzles. A Stage I and Stage II vapor recovery would be used for gasoline emission control. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. W. Collins is the assigned Division person.

#### THIRD APPLICANT:

The applicant is Civil Constructors, Inc. with a mailing address of PO Box 685, Franklin, TN 37064. They seek to obtain air contaminant permits for construction of a Rock Crushing Facility located at 717 South Mt. Juliet Road in Mt. Juliet, TN, as follows:

(1) Rock Crushing and Screening Operations (Division identification number: 95-0277-01/62681). The proposed operations would consist of an RK1012T Impactor, a Pioneer Screener, and associated equipment used to crush onsite rock for backfilling operations. Wet suppression would be used for pollution control. There

would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. D. Wright is the assigned Division person.

(2) Diesel Engine (Division identification number: 95-0277-02/62691). This proposed operation would consist of a Caterpillar C9 224 KW diesel engine, and associated equipment used to power the rock crushing and screening operations. This engine is certified to meet Tier II standards. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. D. Wright is the assigned Division person.
