

New Source Review newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications, May 14, 2009. The following public notices have been published in the newspapers listed below each advertisement. These newspaper advertisements for construction permit applications were published on one of the following dates: May 12, May 13, or May 14, 2009. Public notices are generally published every two weeks. The previous publication of public notices was April 30, 2009.

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) has received requests for construction and/or modification of air contaminant sources as noted below. The proposed construction and/or modification is subject to part 1200-3-9-.01(1)(h) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations, which requires a public notification and 30-day public comment period. Interested parties may express their comments and concerns in writing to Mr. Barry R. Stephens, Director, Division of Air Pollution Control, 9th Floor, L & C Annex, 401 Church Street, Nashville, Tennessee 37243-1531 within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice. Questions concerning a source may be addressed to the assigned Division personnel at the same address or by calling 615-532-0554.

Individuals with disabilities who wish to participate should contact the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation to discuss any auxiliary aids or services needed to facilitate such participation. Such contact may be in person, by writing, telephone, or other means, and should be made no less than ten days prior to the end of the public comment period to allow time to provide such aid or services. The applicant is Fresenius Medical Care - North America with a mailing address of 100 Galleria Parkway, Suite 500, Atlanta, Georgia 30339. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 62-0169-01/62755) for construction of a No. 2 fuel oil emergency generator located at 783 New Highway 68, Sweetwater, TN 37938. This proposed operation would consist of an emergency generator used to serve the outpatient dialysis facility during commercial power outages. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Ms. Hymelia Craig is the assigned Division person.

For the *Monroe County Advocate* -- published once on or before Thursday, May 14, 2009.

The applicant is Wellmont Health System with a mailing address of P.O. Box 238, Kingsport, Tennessee 37662. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 82-0326-02/62764) for construction of a No. 2 fuel oil emergency generator located at 130 West Ravine Road, Kingsport, TN 37660. This proposed operation would consist of an emergency generator used as a part of the new D Tower expansion, which includes an emergency department and intensive care unit rooms, during commercial power outages. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Ms. Hymelia Craig is the assigned Division person.

For Sullivan County *Kingsport Times-News* -- published once on or before Thursday, May 14, 2009.

The applicant is Companions Forever, Inc. with a mailing address of P.O. Box 93, Morrison, TN 37357. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 89-0151-01/62768) for construction of a Pet Crematory Incinerator located at 378 Cooper Road, Morrison, TN 37357. This crematory would consist of a multi-chamber incinerator used to cremate deceased animal remains. Propane would serve as fuel for the

incinerator. The incinerator would have internal afterburner for pollution control. There would be physical construction and regulated air contaminants emitted by this source. Mr. W. Collins is the assigned Division person.

For the Warren County *Southern Standard* -- published once on or before Thursday, May 14, 2009.

The applicant is OmniSource – Johnson City. Formerly Johnson City Iron with a mailing address of 110 Perma R. Road, Johnson City, TN 37604-9099. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 90-0235-01/62055) for construction of a Scrap Automobile Shredder at 110 Perma R. Road, Johnson City, TN 37604-9099. This proposed operation would consist of a 3500 Horse Power Electric Motor and associated equipment used to Scrap Automobiles. A wet scrubber control would be used for pollution control. There will not be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. Malcolm Butler is the assigned Division person.

For the Washington County *Johnson City Press* -- published once on or before Thursday, May 14, 2009.

The applicant is Cooper Recycling, LLC dba Cooper Recycling Shredding Facility with a mailing address of 964 Airport Road, Livingston, Tennessee 38570. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 67-0051-01/62424) for construction of a damp shredding facility located at 104 Bethsaida Road, Monroe, TN 38543. This proposed operation would consist of one (1) infeed conveyor, heavy service dual discharge shredder, conveying and cleaning system, main drive motor, and associated equipment used to shred car bodies, miscellaneous loose appliances, #2 scrap, and light #1 scrap. Mill water injection and a cyclone would be used for pollution control. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Ms. E. Peeler is the assigned Division person.
