

PUBLIC NOTICE

Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company has applied to the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Division (TAPCD) for [renewal of their major source Title V operating permit](#) subject to the provisions of paragraph 1200-3-9-.02(11) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations (also frequently referred to as Title V regulations). A major source (Title V) operating permit is required by both the Federal Clean Air Act and the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations.

The applicant is **Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company** with a site address of 434 Tennessee Gas Drive, Lobelville, TN 37097. They seek to renew their existing major source Title V operating permit for a natural gas transmission compressor station.

Interested parties are invited to review these materials and comment. In addition, a public hearing may be requested at which written or oral presentations may be made. To be considered, written comments or requests for a public hearing must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice and should be addressed to **Mr. Barry R. A final determination will be made after weighing all relevant comments.
