Tennessee State Parks offer a variety of camping options – wrangler camps, back country camps, RV camping, tent camping and group camps that make a great home base for weekend fun or family vacations. For information about camping facilities and availability contact a park directly.

Cedars of Lebanon - Cedars of Lebanon State Park has 117 campsites, all with picnic tables and grills, electric and water hookups. There are 30 tent and pop-up sites available. Three bathhouses provide hot showers and restrooms. There is a camp store, souvenir shop, laundromat and a dumping station for self-contained camping rigs. The campground is open year-round and is available on a first-come, first-served basis. Maximum stay is two weeks. A modern group lodge, has a sleeping capacity of 80 people.

David Crockett - David Crockett State Park has two campgrounds containing a total of 107 sites, each equipped with a table and grill plus electrical and water hookups. Bathhouses provide hot showers, commodes and lavatories. A dump station available for self-contained rigs. Campsites are provided on a first-come, first-served basis. Stay limit is two weeks.

Natchez Trace - Natchez Trace State Park has 208 campsites and five camping cabins in four different areas. Pin Oak RV campground has 77 sites located on the shore of Pin Oak Lake and can accommodate RVs up to 80 feet in length. The RV camp also offers a swimming beach, playground, picnic shelter, camping cabins and boat dock, bathhouses, electric, sewer and water hookups. There are four backcountry campsites and up to 35 people may camp at any one site. The Bucksport Wrangler Camp features 62 campsites, one camping cabin, a bathhouse and restroom and a dump station. The campground is open year round. Campsites are first come, first served. The park also includes four lakes, a swimming beach, restaurant complex, picnicking sites, playgrounds, ball field, archery range and park store.

Reelfoot Lake - Reelfoot Lake State Park operates two campgrounds on Reelfoot Lake. All sites have 30 amp electric service, water, picnic tables and grills. Both campgrounds have a small number of primitive sites with water accessible and picnic tables only. These sites are rented on a first-come, first-served basis. Stay is limited to two weeks.

Roan Mountain - All of Roan Mountain State Park's 107 family campsites have a grill and picnic table and are located near a bathhouse with hot showers. A dump station is located at the campground check-in. The campground has 87 RV sites with water and electric hookups and 20 tent sites that are served by two community water spigots. The tent camping area does not have electric or water hookups. All 107 campsites are available on a first come, first served basis only. Four group sites, which will accommodate approximately 25 people each, are available for non-profit groups and may be reserved up to a year in advance.
