Tennessee State Parks have several options for horse riders. With many miles of trail, bringing your own horse or renting from one of the stables a rider is bound to find just the right park.

Cedars of Lebanon - Approximately one hour east of Nashville, Cedars of Lebanon offers 12.5 miles of marked trails for horseback riding. You can also explore more than 100 miles of state forestry fire trails. A 2.5 mile guided trail ride is offered along with pony rides, overnight boarding, horsemanship classes, birthday barn parties, gift certificates and group discounts. Please call for age and weight limits and reservations.

Chickasaw - Whether you bring your own or rent a horse from us, Chickasaw provides total equestrian fun! Guided trail rides are offered, or you can explore the approximately 100 miles of trail in Chickasaw State Forest. A wrangler campground featuring 32 sites with water and electric hookups is located near the stables. Horses may be picketed at the campsites. A bathhouse with shower and restroom facilities are available, as well as a lighted arena and playground.

Natchez Trace - With approximately 250 miles of riding trails, horseback riding at Natchez Trace is a must-do. Enjoy guided rides on gentle horses or take part in one of the organized overnight trail rides. The Bucksport Wrangler Camp features 65 campsites, a bathhouse and a dump station. Campsites are first come, first served. Overnight boarding is available at the equestrian center barn. Pony rides are available for the very young and pony riders receive a free cowboy hat!

Panther Creek - Panther Creek State Park offers seven miles of scenic horseback riding trail with more under construction. Rental horses are not available so visitors must bring their own horse. Horse trailers use the parking area off Panther Creek Road, just to the west of Boat Ramp Road. This area has maps which show the horse trail.

Warriors' Path - Warriors' Path State Park offers a selection of gentle riding horses and ponies for rent at the park stables. A 5-mile riding trail winds through scenic woodlands to make your guided ride an enriching and entertaining experience. Pony rides for children are also offered, and boarding for horses is available for a monthly fee.

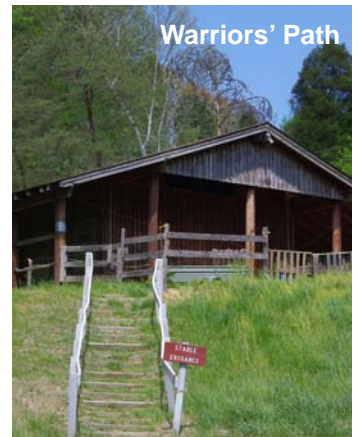
