NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF A PERMIT APPLICATION
FOR A SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL FACILITY

Smith Mountain Solutions, LLC has applied to the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) for a solid waste disposal facility permit to construct and operate a new Class II landfill, Smith Mountain Coal Ash Monofill, IDL 18-0217. The facility is located in Cumberland County, at 6728 Smith Mountain Road, approximately 8 miles northeast of Crab Orchard, Tennessee (latitude 35°59'39" N/longitude 84°44'47" W). The waste materials to be accepted are classified as coal combustion products (coal ash).

Under State law, the applicant must obtain a permit before constructing or operating the proposed facility Class II landfill. DSWM has received a Part I Permit Application indicating Smith Mountain Solutions, LLC 's desire to obtain the required permit.

A complete permit application consists of both a Part I and a Part II, as described in Regulations Governing Solid Waste Processing and Disposal Facilities in Tennessee, Rule 1200-1-7-.02(2)(c). Upon receipt of a complete Part I and Part II application, DSWM will do an in-depth review to determine if the application meets the technical standards of the Regulations described in Rule Chapter 1200-1-7-.04(9), Solid Waste Processing and Disposal. Once the technical review of the application is completed, DSWM will make a tentative decision to either grant or to deny the permit and will issue a public notice of such decision. This second notice will provide the public at least 45 days to submit written comments on the proposed action and will provide for a public hearing. After the public hearing and consideration of all comments received, the DSWM Director shall issue a response to comments and a final permit decision.
