PUBLIC NOTICE OF DECISION TO TRANSFER PERMITS

Green South, LLC Class II Landfills (IDL 60-0017 and IDL 60-0030)
Change of Ownership

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC), Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM), has issued final permit decisions (for two permits), pursuant to Rule 1200-1-7-.02(3)(i) and (j). of Tennessee's Solid Waste Program Processing and Disposal Regulations. RLF Green Duck, LLC has applied, pursuant to a change of ownership, for a minor permit modification to transfer the permits for the existing Green South, LLC Class II Landfills (IDL 60-0017 and IDL 60-0030) from the previous owner. The two (2) disposal facilities, which will be identified as RLF Green Duck Class II Landfill (Active) and RLF Green Duck PC Class II Landfill (Not Active in Post Closure), are located in Maury County, at 2262 Monsanto Road (southeast of the plant site, located north of Highway 50 West), approximately four (4) miles northwest of Columbia, Tennessee (latitude 35°39'37" N/ longitude 87°07'22" W). The final decision to issue these two permits was made on May 18, 2009.
