NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE PERMIT
FOR A SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL FACILITY

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC), Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM), has tentatively decided to issue a solid waste disposal facility permit to BFI Waste Systems of North America, LLC for construction, operation, closure, and post-closure care of Class III Landfill for the disposal of farming wastes, landscaping and land clearing wastes, construction/demolition wastes, shredded automotive tires, and/or certain wastes having similar characteristics and approved in writing by the Department. The BFI Waste Systems of North America, LLC is proposing to reclassify Sector 10 of the North Shelby Class I Landfill (SNL 79-0224) to a Class III facility within the existing footprint of the Class I facility. Sector 10 is an approved Class I facility that will be downgraded to a Class III facility.

The facility, identified as DML 79-0122, is located in Shelby County, at 7111 Old Millington Road, Millington, Tennessee (latitude 35°20'09" N/ longitude 89°57'11" W). No hazardous wastes, as regulated by the Tennessee Hazardous Waste Management Act (Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-212-101, et. seq.) and the Rules adopted pursuant to the Act, shall be accepted for disposal at this facility. The official responsible for operation of the facility is Larry Hubbard, General Manager, BFI Waste Systems of North America, LLC, 7111 Old Millington Road, Memphis, TN 38053; telephone: 901-872-7258.

Following an in-depth review of the application, DSWM has made a preliminary determination that this proposal meets the applicable requirements of Tennessee Rule Chapter 1200-1-7, Solid Waste Processing and Disposal. It is the present intent of DSWM, pending consideration of any contrary technical information received during the public comment period ending on June 22, 2009, that this permit be issued. During the public comment period provided, any interested person may submit written comments on the draft permit and may request a public hearing. A request for a public hearing shall be in writing and shall state the nature of the issues proposed to be raised in the hearing. Comments must be received by 4:30 p.m. CDT on Monday, June 22, 2009, to assure consideration. After considering all public comments, the DSWM Director will issue a final permit decision and a Response to Comments, which can be viewed at the Millington Public Library or at the TDEC Field Office in Memphis.
