PUBLIC NOTICE OF DECISION TO TRANSFER PERMIT

Custom Tire and Recycle Class II Landfill Change of Ownership

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC), Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM), has issued a final permit decision, pursuant to Rule 1200-1-7-.02(3)(i) and (j). of Tennessee's Solid Waste Program Processing and Disposal Regulations. Environmental Waste Solutions, LLC has applied, pursuant to a change of ownership, for a minor permit modification to transfer the permit for the existing Custom Tire and Recycle Class II Landfill, and ID#: IDL 03-0212, from the previous owner Custom Tire and Recycle, LLC. The disposal facility, which will be identified as EWS Camden Class II Landfill, is located in Benton County at 200 Omar Circle, Camden, Tennessee (latitude 36°03'16" N/ longitude 88°05'16" W). The final decision to issue the permit was made on October 5, 2009.
