PUBLIC NOTICE OF DECISION TO TRANSFER PERMIT

Poplar View Class III Landfill Change of Ownership

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC), Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM), has issued a final permit decision, pursuant to Rule 1200-1-7-.02(3)(i) and (j). of Tennessee's Solid Waste Program Processing and Disposal Regulations. Poplar View Landfill, Inc. has applied, pursuant to a change of ownership, for a minor permit modification to transfer the permit for the existing Poplar View Class III Landfill, DML 47-0057, from the previous owner, Construction & Demolition Landfill Services, Inc. The facility is located in Knox County at 7826 Rutledge Pike, Knoxville, Tennessee (latitude 36°02'34" N/ longitude 83°45'46" W). The final decision to issue the permit was made on April 9, 2009.
