

NOTICE OF INTENT TO REISSUE A HAZARDOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT PERMIT TO SAFETY-KLEEN SYSTEMS, INC

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation's (TDEC) Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) proposes to reissue a hazardous waste management permit to **Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc.**, that would allow the facility to continue to operate an existing hazardous waste storage facility. This action follows the pre-application public meeting conducted by the facility on April 18, 2006, as required by Tennessee Rule 1200-1-11-.07(2)(c)3(i). No members of the community attended the public meeting.

Safety-Kleen Systems Inc., EPA ID Number: **TND 00 061 4321**, located at **3536 Fite Road, Millington, TN 38053**, is currently permitted under Tennessee Permit Number **TNHW-091**, issued on August 22, 1996. The current permit was effective for ten years. Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc. submitted Part A and Part B Applications to DSWM for renewal of the facility's hazardous waste management permit on March 6, 2006, thus enabling the facility to continue to operate under the current permit until a final decision is made. The receipt of the renewal application was public noticed on March 15, 2006.

In the current permit the maximum quantity of waste stored at the facility is 10,000 gallons in an aboveground Storage Tank, 17,690 gallons in a Container Storage Area, and 300 gallons in a Return and Fill unit. The Return and Fill unit has been reclassified as a miscellaneous unit. The hazardous materials stored in these units include petroleum naphtha parts washer solvent, aqueous solvent, immersion cleaner, dry cleaning waste and paint waste collected from customers or generated on-site. The proposed permit is for the continuance of these units.

Included as part of this draft permit are the corrective action conditions for the solid waste management units (SWMUs) and areas of concern (AOCs) at the facility. Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc. will be required to investigate any release of hazardous waste or hazardous constituents at the facility, regardless of the time at which waste was placed in a unit, and to take appropriate correct action for any such releases. The proposed permit also requires notification of imminent hazards, and when applicable, compliance with the requirements developed under land disposal restrictions and organic emission standards.

The permit is proposed to be reissued under the authority of the Tennessee Hazardous Waste Management Act of 1977, as amended, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-212-101 et seq., and Rule Chapter 1200-1-11, Hazardous Waste Management.

After considering all public comments received, the DSWM Director will issue a final permit decision and a Response to Comments.
