NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, the Division of Water Pollution Control will hold a public hearing pursuant to Rule 1200-4-5-.06 (8).

Public comments will be received concerning the draft NPDES Permit for Discharges of Treated Stormwater Associated with TEPPCO Clifton Fuels Terminal. TEPPCO proposes to intermittently discharge approximately 0.15 million gallons per day from a detention pond to Kentucky Reservoir on the Tennessee River at mile 159.5.

Comments will also be received regarding the Aquatic Resources Alteration Permit required for the installation of the barge mooring structure associated with the terminal.

The hearing officer may limit the length of oral presentation in order to allow parties an opportunity to speak, and will require that all testimony be relevant to water quality issues. Written testimony will be accepted at the hearing, for ten working days following the hearing, and will be considered part of the hearing record.

Interested persons may obtain additional information, a copy of the draft permit, the rationale and inspect and copy forms and related documents at the Division's Central Office at the address listed above. You may make an appointment with Ms. Monya Bradley to view the permit by calling (615) 532-0664.

Individuals with disabilities who wish to participate in these proceedings (or review the administrative file record) should contact the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation to discuss any auxiliary aids or services needed to facilitate such participation. Contact may be in person, by writing, telephone, or other means, and should be made no less than ten working days prior to the hearing, to allow time to provide such aid or services.
