The site is located at latitude 36°31'39" and longitude 83°51'21". The draft permit issued for this new underground coal mine was announced in Public Notice M2009-20 on November 6, 2009.

The draft NPDES permit covers discharges of treated wastewater and stormwater to Spruce Lick Branch. This stream is not listed as impaired in the "EPA Approved Final Version Year 2008 303(d) List" and is not identified or designated as Exceptional Tennessee Waters (ETWs). The site is located at latitude 36°09'35" and longitude 84°17'56". The draft permit issued for this new contour surface coal mine with highwall auger was announced in Public Notice M2009-20 on November 6, 2009.

The draft NPDES permit covers discharges of treated wastewater and stormwater to unnamed tributaries of Ligias Fork, unnamed tributary of Blue Hole Branch, and unnamed tributaries of Carroll Branch. Blue Hole Branch and Carroll Branch are named tributaries to Ligias Fork in the South Fork of the Cumberland River Sub-watershed. The affected stream reach of Ligias Fork is from stream miles 1.5 to 5.0 and is not listed as impaired in the "EPA Approved Final Version Year 2008 303(d) List."

The Division had classified Ligias Fork, from mouth at New River to confluence with Eli Branch, stream mile 1.2, as Exceptional Tennessee Waters (ETWs) due to the presence of State Threatened Ashy Darter. According to the mine plan, no outfalls will discharge to any named tributary of the ETW reach of Ligias Fork. Hearing Procedures

The hearing officer may limit oral presentations to five minutes and require that all testimony be relevant to water quality-related issues for these facilities. Undue repetition in oral presentations should be avoided so that all interested parties will have an opportunity to present their concerns relative to water quality issues. Written testimony will be accepted at the hearing and for at least ten days following the hearing.

Comments not related to water quality or to the information contained in the permit applications will not be accepted nor considered part of the hearing record. Issues not directly related to water quality or to the draft permits, such as safety, blasting, traffic or related issues will not be considered. We do not control these matters and consideration would not contribute relevant information to the decision making process for the NPDES permit applications.

Interested persons may obtain additional information and copy the applications, draft permits, and supporting documentation from the permit files maintained at the Mining Section's office at the letterhead address. There is a nominal fee for copying. These files are available for public inspection during normal visiting hours by contacting Tina.E.Jones@tn.gov or call (865) 594-5616 to schedule an appointment for the review. A copy of the permit applications and draft permits will be available for review at the hearing.
