Public comments will be received concerning the proposed permit action described below:

Tennessee proposes to issue an Individual NPDES Permit to Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency, Permit Number TN0081051, for activities located at various sites on Reelfoot Lake, Tiptonville, TN, Lake and Obion Counties, Tennessee. This permit is to authorize spraying noxious vegetation in Reelfoot Lake to provide access for the public, law enforcement, and search and rescue. Treatment will be applied by a licensed aquatic herbicide applicator.

The hearing officer may limit the length of oral presentation in order to allow parties an opportunity to speak, and will require that all testimony be relevant to water quality issues. Written testimony will be accepted at the hearing, for ten working days following the hearing, and will be considered part of the hearing record.

Interested persons may obtain additional information, a copy of the draft permit, the rationale and inspect and copy forms and related documents at the Division's Central Office at the address listed above, Attn.: Elizabeth Rorie, (615) 532-1172, or at the Jackson Environmental Field Office located at 1625 Hollywood Drive, Jackson, TN 38305, (731) 512-1300.
