V. GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

- A. Lebanon Surgical Center, Lebanon (Wilson County), TN — CN0702-011A
Request for a one (1) year extension of the expiration date from July 1, 2009 to July 1, 2010. This project was approved on May 23, 2007 for the replacement and relocation of the existing multi-specialty surgery center, an increase in operating rooms from one (1) to three (3), and an increase in procedure rooms from one (1) to two (2). The facility is to be constructed by a third party and leased back to the applicant for an initial period of ten (10) years. The project cost is \$8,625,538.00.

- B. Alliance Health Services, Inc. d/b/a Methodist Alliance Hospice, Memphis (Shelby County), TN — CN0709-067A
Request for a two (2) year extension of the expiration date from February 1, 2010 to February 1, 2012. This project was approved on December 12, 2007 for the establishment of a thirty (30) bed residential hospice facility and the initiation of residential hospice services. The service area includes Shelby, Fayette and Tipton Counties with a project cost of \$9,179,386.00
