Renovated spaces in the existing building will include limited rearrangement of internal partitions to facilitate new uses of existing spaces which will receive new flooring, wall coverings and paint. This will increase the licensed bed complement from 135 to 160.
Scott	CN0707-057	Huntsville Manor	<b>Withdrawn</b>	<del>10/24/07</del> Deferred to 12/12/07	The addition of twenty-four (24) skilled nursing home beds dually certified for Medicare and Medicaid. This project will increase the licensed bed complement from 96 to 120.

Coffee	CN0707-061	United Regional Medical Center Nursing Home	<b>Approved</b> [Without addition of new beds]	12/12/07	The relocation and replacement of the existing licensed nursing home facility and the addition of thirty (30) new Medicare certified nursing home beds for a total of 102 nursing home beds. The nursing home is currently located at 1001 McArthur Drive and the proposed location contains approximately twenty-three (23) acres at the southeast corner of the intersection of McArthur Drive and Oak Drive, Manchester (Coffee County), TN. United Regional Medical Center plans to transfer the nursing home to Capital Funding, Inc., which will in turn lease it to Health Services, Inc., the proposed manager. The project will be part of a planned new hospital campus for the United Regional Medical Center on the same site. \$ 9,286,849.00 <b>Note:</b> The applicant withdrew the request for the thirty (30) additional Medicare-certified beds. The space where the beds were to be located will be used for assisted living which is not CON reviewable.
Shelby	CN0802-006	Millington Healthcare Center	<b>Approved</b>	6/25/08	The addition of nineteen (19)* Medicare skilled beds increasing the licensed nursing home bed complement from sixty-six (66) to eighty-five (85).
Williamson	CN0804-030	Somerfield at the Heritage	<b>Approved</b>	8/27/08	The addition of thirty (30) skilled nursing facility beds. This project will increase the beds from thirty-six (36) to sixty-six (66) and all beds will be Medicare certified.
Cumberland	CN0806-035	Good Samaritan Society Fairfield Glade	<b>Approved</b>	9/24/08	The establishment of a new thirty (30)-bed nursing home for skilled nursing services. If approved the beds will be licensed as nursing home beds and dually certified for participation in Medicare and Medicaid. The nursing home will be located on a not yet assigned address on the corner of the intersection of Catoosa Boulevard and North Ridge Drive in the Fairfield Glade community of Crossville (Cumberland County), TN.

Hamilton	CN0806-038	Life Care Center of Missionary Ridge	<b>Approved for 21 beds</b>	9/24/08	The replacement and relocation of a current 78-bed nursing home facility from 708 Dwight Avenue to 5501 Old Hixson Pike, Chattanooga (Hamilton County), TN (approximately 10 miles away). The new construction will replace the existing forty-one year old building. The addition of thirty (30) beds, increasing the beds from 78 to 108. However, there will be no net increase in certified beds from the Hamilton County service area as Life Care Center of East Ridge will de-certify thirty (30) beds upon approval of this project.
