The initiation of magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) services and the acquisition by lease of MRI equipment. OrthoMemphis will enter into a lease agreement with Baptist Memorial Rehabilitation Services, Inc. (BMRS), whereby OrthoMemphis will block lease MRI time, space and staff from BMRS in a MRI outpatient facility. A separate Certificate of Need has been filed by BMRS. The MRI service to be operated by OrthoMemphis pursuant to the lease agreement will be limited to OrthoMemphis patients. The MRI will be managed by BMRS. As a private physician practice, there is no health care institution licensure involved.

The MRI as well as the clinical offices will relocate from 1223½ Trotwood Avenue, Columbia (Maury County), TN to a site located at the west side of the 900 block of James Campbell Boulevard, between Hampshire Pike and Old Williamsport Boulevard, Columbia (Maury County), TN. As a private physician practice, there is no health care licensure involved. The only change in health care services is the change of the MRI scanning capability from extremities only to full body scanning. The MRI service will continue to be limited to the patients of Mid-Tennessee Bone & Joint.
