1	1910.1030	Occupational Exposure to Bloodborne Pathogens	absence of, or deficiencies in, exposure control plan, engineering and work practice controls, recordkeeping, training, hepatitis B vaccinations and post-exposure follow-up
2	0800-01-10	Sharps Injury Prevention	type and brand of device in use when an exposure incident occurred not recorded on the sharps injury log within 6 days of the incident; engineered sharps injury protection evaluated and currently in use not documented in the exposure control plan
3	0800-01-03	OSHA 300 Log Recordkeeping	recordable injury or illness not entered on form 300 or 301 in 7 days; 300 log not completed or not completed in required detail; names not removed from the 300 form for privacy cases; annual summary (300A) incomplete; annual summary (300A) not properly certified
4	1910.1200	Hazard Communication	lack of, or deficiencies in, written program, training, labels, MSDS
5	1910.37	Maintenance, Safeguards, etc. for Exit Routes	exit routes not free and unobstructed; exit routes not clearly visible and marked by an "EXIT" sign; sign indicating direction of travel to nearest exit not posted
6	1910.132	Personal Protective Equipment	no written certification of ppe hazard assessment
7	1910.134	Respiratory Protection	improper storage of respirators; appendix D not provided to voluntary respirator users
8	1910.157	Portable Fire Extinguishers	portable fire extinguishers not accessible; no monthly visual inspection of fire extinguishers
9	1910.303	Electrical: General	disconnecting means or overcurrent device not marked; width of working space in front of electric equipment inadequate
10	0800-01-09	Tennessee Right-to-Know Law	training on hazardous chemicals not conducted annually
