SENATE BILL NO. 201

AN ACT To amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 24; Title 38, Chapter 8, Part 1 and Title 68, Chapter 140, relative to requiring domestic violence training for law enforcement personnel, firefighters and emergency medical services personnel.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 38-8-112, is amended by inserting the language "and domestic violence training" between the word "arrest" and the period.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 24, Part 1, is amended by adding the following language as a new section to be designated as follows:

Section 4-24-111. The curriculum requirements of the commission on firefighting personnel standards and education shall include materials concerning domestic violence training.

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 68, Chapter 140, Part 5, is amended by adding the following language as a new section to be designated as follows:

Section 68-140-523. As a part of its training curriculum for emergency medical services personnel, the department shall approve and coordinate the use of materials concerning domestic violence.


SECTION 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001, the public welfare requiring it.
