AN ACT To amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 54 and Title 55.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:


SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55, Chapter 4, Part 1, is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated section:

Section 55-4-133. To increase public knowledge of the availability of used oil collection facilities and the benefits of recycling used oil, the Department of Safety shall conduct a promotional campaign, including, but not limited to, the inclusion of information concerning the used oil collection act pursuant to § 68-211-1001 et seq. with motor vehicle registration renewal notices. Such information shall include used oil collection sites and the toll-free telephone information number established by the Department of Environment and Conservation pursuant to § 68-211-1005. The Department of Safety may include additional information as deemed appropriate by the department.

SECTION 2. Any cost relative to the implementation of this act shall come from funds derived from taxes authorized by the Used Oil Act of 1993, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-211-1001, et seq.


SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001, the public welfare requiring it.
