WHEREAS, Senator Springer was a person of impeccable morals and irreproachable integrity, who worked assiduously to establish a brighter future for the good people of the 25th Senatorial District and of the state as a whole; and

WHEREAS, In appreciation of his meritorious record of public service, the members of this General Assembly join with the citizens of Hickman County and the 25th Senatorial District to name a segment of State Route 48 and State Route 100 to permanently commemorate Pete Springer's bountiful life of purpose and commitment to the greater good; now, therefore,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable signs designating such combined segment of State Route 48 and State Route 100 as the "Kenneth N. 'Pete' Springer Highway".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the erection of such directional signs shall be within the guidelines prescribed by the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution shall take effect only if funding for the resolution is specifically provided in an appropriations act or, if funding is not provided in an appropriations act, funding is provided through non-state sources.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution shall become operative only if the Federal Highway Administrator advises the Commissioner of Transportation in writing that the provisions of this resolution shall not render Tennessee in violation of federal laws and regulations and subject to penalties prescribed therein.

WHEREAS, Children with autism often have educational and social needs in other service domains; and

WHEREAS, Autism is a pervasive developmental disorder; and

WHEREAS, Symptom management, respite services such as those provided by Tennessee Voices for Children and case management can be provided to children if it is determined they have a co-occurring psychiatric disorder or are determined to be seriously emotionally disturbed (SED); and

WHEREAS, SED status is defined as experiencing significant impairment of functioning in addition to having another psychiatric disorder besides a developmental or substance abuse or chemical dependency disorder; and

WHEREAS, Diagnostic and treatment services offered under the EPSDT program must meet medically necessary criteria if those services extend beyond basic, periodic screenings; and

WHEREAS, Other services are educational in nature, or both medical and educational in nature (such as speech therapy), leading to substantial complexity, overlap, and the potential for failure to meet adequately the needs of children with autism; and

WHEREAS, TennCare-funded services are only one source of funding, and there are limits to the scope of services that TennCare can provide since services must meet certain criteria; and

WHEREAS, Other states have taken a proactive approach such as developing university-based and specialized programs that coordinate and integrate services for children with autism and their families, while blending funding resources; and

WHEREAS, The array and complexity of needs and service requirements for children with autism demonstrates the need for a comprehensive statewide plan for children; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, That the Departments of Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities, Education, Children's Services, the TennCare bureau, and the Tennessee Commission on Children and Youth conduct a study of current services and programs available for children with autism and their families.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That these departments, the bureau, and the commission are authorized to consult with such other agencies and institutions of state government as they deem appropriate in conducting this study.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That these departments, the bureau, and the commission prepare a proposal for a comprehensive statewide plan for coordinating services and maximizing their delivery to children with autism and their families.





WHEREAS, The citizens of Cumberland County have requested that a certain route be named to honor and recognize all those brave sons and daughters of Cumberland County who sacrificed personal concerns and their safety, with many of them giving their lives, so that we might enjoy the many bounties of democracy and the American way of life; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, That the segment of U.S. Highway 127 in Cumberland County, from its Plateau Road Intersection south to the Intersection at State Route 68, is hereby designated the "Veterans Memorial Highway".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable signs or to affix suitable markers designating such segment of State Route 127 as the "Veterans Memorial Highway".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the erection of such signs shall be within the guidelines prescribed by the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution shall become operative only if the Federal Highway Administrator advises the Commissioner of Transportation in writing that the provisions of this resolution shall not render Tennessee in violation of federal laws and regulations and subject to penalties prescribed therein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution shall become operative only if Cumberland County, either (1) remits the estimated cost of the erection of such signs to the Department of Transportation within one (1) year of the effective date of this resolution, or (2) manufactures and erects such signs pursuant to state and federal guidelines and as approved by the Department. If electing option (1), Cumberland County shall make such payment prior to any expenditure by the state for manufacture or installation of such signs. The Department shall return any unused portion of the estimated cost to Cumberland County within thirty (30) days of the erection of such signs. If the actual cost exceeds the estimated cost, Cumberland County shall remit an amount equal to the difference in such costs to the Department within thirty (30) days of receiving an itemized invoice of the actual cost from the Department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a certified copy of this resolution be transmitted to the Commissioner of Transportation and to the Cumberland County Commission.
