All days appointed by the governor of this state, or by the president of the United States, as days of fasting or thanksgiving; and when any of the above days fall on Sunday, then the following Monday is substituted, and when any of these days fall on Saturday, then the preceding Friday shall be substituted.

### Days of Special Observance

Pursuant to the provisions of *Tennessee Code Annotated §15-2-101*, each year it shall be the duty of the governor to proclaim the following as days of special observance:

Robert E. Lee Day .....	January 19
Abraham Lincoln Day .....	February 12
Andrew Jackson Day .....	March 15
Memorial or Confederate Decoration Day .....	June 3
Nathan Bedford Forrest Day .....	July 13
Mother's Day .....	Second Sunday in May ( <i>TCA §15-2-102</i> )

*Tennessee Code Annotated §15-2-103* states that the first day of June of each year is declared an historical day to commemorate the admission of the state into the Union, such day to be known as "Statehood Day"; provided, that this day is not a legal holiday.

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
