CHILDREN, CASES, AND REFERRALS

NUMBER OF INDIVIDUAL CHILDREN, CASES AND REFERRAL COUNTS BY COURT - 2008

The juvenile courts reporting the largest number of children referred whose cases were disposed in CY 2008 were Shelby County/Memphis who reported 13,713, Davidson County/Nashville who reported 8,748, Knox County/Knoxville who reported 5,369, Hamilton County/Chattanooga who reported 4,936, and Blount County who reported 2,875. Hancock County had the lowest number of children referred and reported 33 children whose cases were disposed in 2008. These statistics and those for each court are shown in the table on the following pages.

The reader should note that the definition of case is as follows: "All referral reasons/charges reported to the court (via complaint, petition, motion, etc.) on a given day for a given child." It is also important to be aware that the juvenile data is counted based on the date of disposition. This is the date that the case is disposed or adjudicated by the juvenile court and then reported to the TCJFCJ during calendar year 2008.

CHILDREN REFERRED TO JUVENILE COURT BY RACE, SEX AND COURT - 2008

The next table depicts the number of children referred to juvenile court by race, sex, and court in 2008. Listed below are the courts with the highest count of children referred in each category by race and sex.

Knox County reported 1,863 White males, Shelby County reported 6,794 African American males, Montgomery County reported 5 Native American males, and Davidson County reported 51 Asian males and 115 Mixed Race males.

Knox County reported 1,403 White females, Shelby County reported 4,516 African American females, Fayette County reported 6 Native American females, and Davidson County reported 27 Asian females. Davidson and Montgomery Counties both reported 86 Mixed Race females.

REFERRALS BY TYPE OF OFFENSE, AGE GROUP, RACE, AND SEX - 2008

The Referrals by Type of Offense, Age Group, Race, and Sex tables in CY 2008 showed the number of referrals for children who were referred to juvenile courts by type of offense, age group, race, and sex within the following categories: Delinquent, Status/Unruly, Dependency and Neglect, Other Violations (“Violation of Pretrial Diversion” and “Violation of Informal Adjustment”), Special Proceedings, and Other (which includes any referrals that do not fall within the categories listed above).

White males in the age group of 15 through 16 years had 13,139, the highest number of referrals in the Delinquent category. African American males were the next highest in this age group whose Delinquent referrals totaled 9,127. White females in the age group of 15 through 16 years had 5,772, the third highest number of referrals in the Delinquent category, and African American females in the age group of 15 through 16 years had 3,698 referrals in the Delinquent category.

Referrals in the Status/Unruly category were most often found in the age group of 15 through 16 years and were broken down as follows: White males at 4,963; White females at 3,252; African American males at 1,747; and African American females at 1,219.

Referrals in the Dependency and Neglect category were highest in the age group Birth through 10 years and totaled 7,264 or 68.4% of the total referrals in the Dependency and Neglect category. Referrals for White males were the highest in the age group Birth through 10 years in the Dependency and Neglect category and totaled 2,150, followed by referrals for White females that totaled 2,124. Referrals for African American males were third and totaled 1,082 while referrals for African American females totaled 1,046.

Referrals in the Other Violations category include Violation of Pretrial Diversion and Violation of Informal Adjustment and totaled 306 of which 144, the highest number for all youth, appeared in the 15 through 16 years age group. White males totaled 84 referrals in this category followed by White females with 51 Other Violations referrals. African American males had only 6 referrals in this category and African American females had only 2 referrals in the Other Violations category.

Referrals in the Special Proceedings category were highest for the age group Birth through 10 years and totaled 22,091 or 43.3% of the total referrals in the Special Proceedings category. Special Proceedings referrals for White males in the age group Birth through 10 years totaled 6,619 followed by referrals for White females that totaled 6,294. African American males were third highest in the age group Birth through 10 years and totaled 2,851 followed by referrals for African American females that totaled 2,595. Special Proceedings referrals include the following: Judicial Review, Administrative Review, Foster Care Review, Custody, Visitation, Paternity/Legitimation, Child Support, Requests for Medical Treatment, and Consent to Marry.*

The category "Other", which is the last category of referral, is the category in which the numbers should be reduced after the future case management and data collection system has been implemented. This category is used to identify those referrals that are not defined in other classifications and the numbers showed that a total of 12,447 referrals were placed in this group.

**LIVING ARRANGEMENT OF THE CHILD AT TIME OF REFERRAL TO JUVENILE COURT -
2008**

Consistent with the data gathered in previous years, the Living Arrangement of Juveniles by Race and Sex for CY 2008 chart showed that within the general juvenile court population and at the time of referral to juvenile court, 35,624 children were reported to be living "With Mother". This was 38.8% of the total of all children referred. The second and third most reported living arrangements for the general juvenile court population were 14,023 or 15.3%, that were reported to be living "With both Biological Parents" and who's living arrangement were "Unknown" at 13,701 or 14.9% of the total of all children referred. Examination of the 2008 juvenile court population by race and gender categories showed the following living arrangement patterns.

Data regarding the living arrangements of White males reflected that at the time of referral to juvenile court 10,751 or 31.8% of a total of 33,825 children, were reported to have been living with "With Mother", followed by 7,596 or 22.5% that were reported to have been living with "With Both Biological Parents", and 4,364 or 12.9% that were reported to have "Unknown" living arrangements.

Data regarding the living arrangements of White females reflected that at the time of referral to juvenile court 8,103 or 35.6% of a total of 22,780 were reported to have been living "With Mother", followed by 4,122 or 18.1% that were reported to have been living with "Both Biological Parents", and 3,070 or 13.5% that were reported to have "Unknown" living arrangements.

Data regarding the living arrangements of 16,658 African American males revealed that at the time of referral to juvenile court there were 8,617 or 51.7% that were reported to have been living "With Mother", followed by 2,184 or 13.1% that were report to have been living "With Relatives", and 1,983 or 11.9% that were reported to have "Unknown" living arrangements.

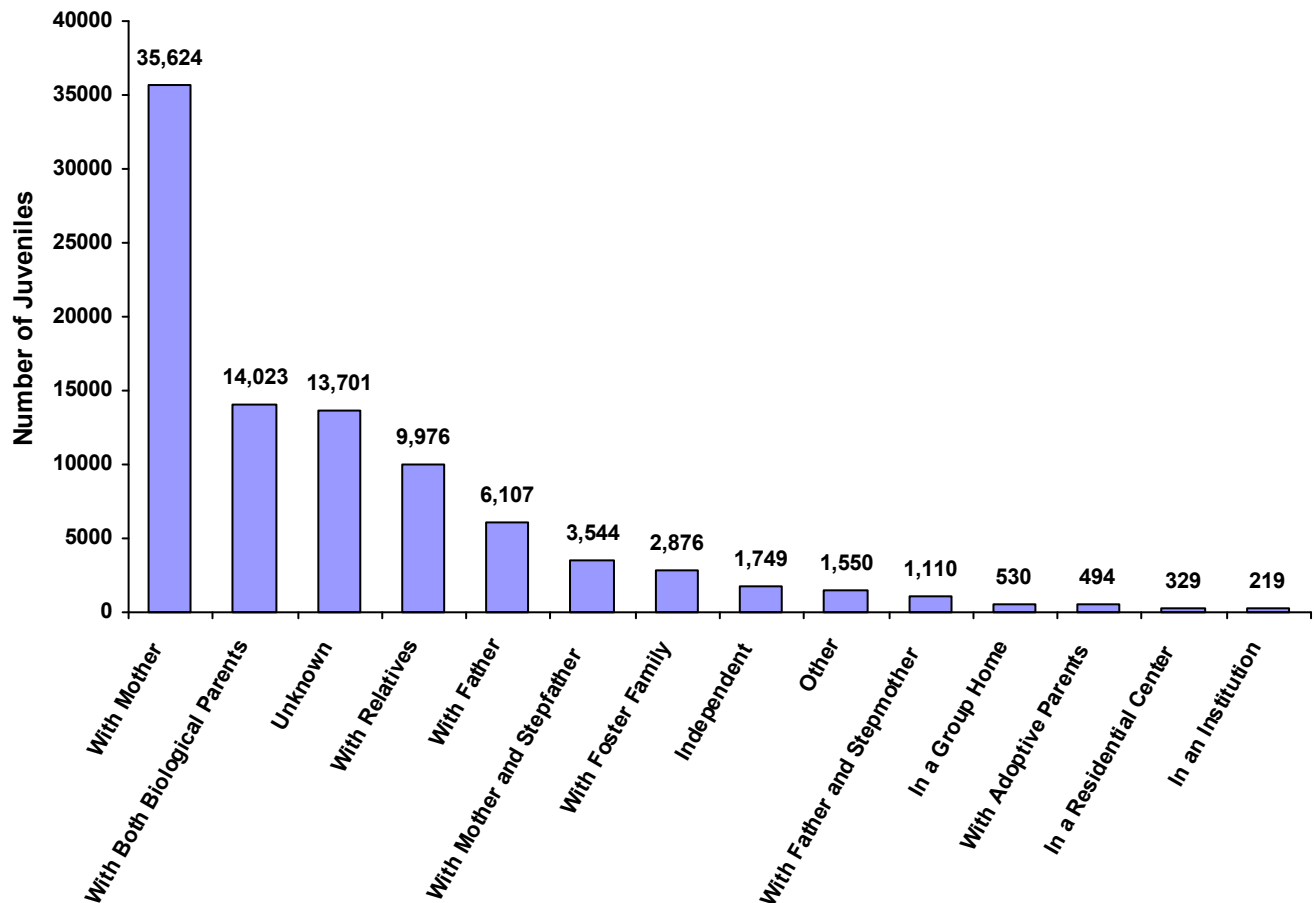
Data regarding the Living Arrangements of 11,248 African American females revealed that at the time of referral to juvenile court 5,962 or 53.0% were reported to have been living "With Mother", followed by 1,626 or 14.5% that were reported to have been living "With Relatives", and 1,439 or 12.8% that were reported to have "Unknown" living arrangements.

SCHOOL STATUS OF INDIVIDUAL CHILDREN AT THE TIME OF REFERRAL TO JUVENILE COURT

In 2008, 61,864 or 67.4% of the juvenile court population were reported as being "Enrolled" in school either full or part-time at the time of referral to juvenile court. There were 12,097 or 13.2% of the juvenile court population that were reported as "Not Enrolled" in school. The "Not Enrolled" in school category also included those children who had been expelled. It should be noted that school enrollment for 17,871 or 19.5% of the juvenile court population was reported as "Unknown".

A total of 3,260 or 3.6% of the juvenile court population was reported as being enrolled in a special education curriculum at the time of referral. There were 50,431 or 54.9% of the juvenile court population that were reported as "Not Enrolled" in a special education curriculum and the special education status of 38,141 children or 41.5% of this same population was reported as "Unknown".
