DISCUSSION ITEM D: Tennessee Education Lottery Scholarship Program Status Report

Staff Recommendation: For discussion only.

Background

As of February 20, 2009, the Tennessee Education Lottery Scholarship (TELS) has just under 94,500 eligible students for various awards at just over \$291 million.

TSAC estimates that for the 2008-2009 award year, 88,000 students will receive a TELS award totaling \$266 million.

Contracts for the Helping Heroes Grant and the Tennessee Rural Health Loan Forgiveness program have been approved by the Department of Finance and Administration and have been distributed to the participating institutions.
