One antlerless deer per hunt, except where otherwise specified.

- A Bag limit - 2 antlerless deer
B West of Hwy. 411 and east of Hwy. 129
C Excludes Cherokee WMA
D East of I-75 only
E West of Tennessee River and south of I-24
F North of Hwy. 411

PERMITS AVAILABLE AUGUST 19, 2009
Beginning at 8 a.m. (Central), 9 a.m. (Eastern)

Most hunting lands in these counties are privately owned.
Issuance of a permit does not guarantee permission to hunt.

FALL TURKEY SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS

- Dec. 7-18. Bag limit is 1 turkey, either sex, per permit except in counties with an asterisk (*).
- In counties with an asterisk (*), bag limit is 3 turkeys, either sex, per permit.

HOW TO OBTAIN PERMITS

- **Your receipt is your permit. You must be in possession of the permit to participate in the hunt.**
- You may begin obtaining permits on **August 19, 2009**, at 8 a.m., CDT. You may obtain permits at any TWRA license agent, at any TWRA regional office, or online at www.tnwildlife.org. If you encounter any problems, call **615-781-6621** during regular office hours (8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. CDT).
- Individuals may have up to two (2) deer and two (2) turkey permits but are eligible for only one (1) permit per hunt code.
- **Permittees must review their permit receipt and verify name, address, hunt locations, fees, etc., upon completion to ensure accuracy.**
- **Permits are not transferable.**

WHEN OBTAINING PERMITS AT A LICENSE AGENT:

- There is no fee for current Annual Sportsman License holders, Lifetime Sportsman License holders, or senior citizen hunters (Type 166) with an Annual Senior Citizen Permit (Type 167). For all other permittees, there is a \$20 permit fee for each permit you obtain, plus a \$1 agent fee.
- When obtaining permits in person, you must remain until your permit is processed to ensure that your information is correct and to receive your receipt with your confirmation number.
- The system only allows for one (1) permit per transaction.

WHEN OBTAINING PERMITS ON THE INTERNET:

- There is no fee for current Annual Sportsman License holders, Lifetime Sportsman License holders, or senior citizen hunters (Type 166) with an Annual Senior Citizen Permit (Type 167). All other permittees will be charged a \$20 permit fee for each permit you obtain, plus a \$2 internet usage fee. The \$2 internet usage fee is collected by the company that maintains the internet site. (It is not a fee that is charged by the TWRA.)
- Go to www.tnwildlife.org. Then click on “**Buy a License Online**,” located on the right side of the page.
- The “**Purchase Confirmation**” page is your receipt.

SPECIAL SEASONS LEFTOVER INFORMATION:

- Beginning September 16, 2009, at 8 a.m., CDT, any quotas left unfilled will be deemed leftover permits.
- Individuals may obtain up to five (5) permits for deer and five (5) permits for turkey per person. Individuals may obtain more than one (1) permit for the same hunt and in any combination of deer and turkey choices. Leftover permits will be available until December 27, 2009.
- The system only allows for one (1) permit per transaction.
- **Permits are not transferable.**
