Discussion/Action Taken: After explaining that the applicant had resolved a matter pursuant to an agreed order, Director Thomas summarized the request and that recommended conditional approval subject to payment of the license fee. Commissioner Tomita asked about the agreed order and any policy on a missed payment from the agreed order. By phone, Commission Counsel member Ryan Mercurio, who had worked with the applicant on the agreed order, responded by saying that the TABC would revoke their license if a payment was missed and then file a notice of hearing. Commissioner Tomita moved approval subject to payment of the license fee and the motion was seconded. The motion passed with three ayes.



7. MISCELLANEOUS

Director's Update
 <u>Discussion/Action Taken</u>: Director Thomas updated the Commission on a couple of items. Director Thomas discussed statutes and policies related to minor compliance checks after receiving a few questions.

Law Enforcement Update Discussion/Action Taken: CLEO Tubbs updated the Commission on enforcement activity since the last meeting including statistics on the number of inspections conducted, citations issued, fine amounts, minor compliance checks and compliance rate, seizures, and personnel news. The reported figures extremely concerned the TABC commissioners and staff. The data revealed out of 261 minor compliance checks conducted between October 22 and November 18, 2020, only 74% refused to sell to a minor attempting to purchase alcohol. Director Thomas responded by saying, "We hope these low numbers are a result of COVID-19's market disruptions and not a trend. We know the industry has lost some experienced staff. This year has been very tough for our licensees, and I have faith we will get this turned around. The health of the industry relies on our licensees complying with state law." Tubbs also mentioned upcoming liquor lot auctions the TABC will post online soon. And finally, Regulatory Officer Mikayla Amundson was sworn in as a Special Agent for the Nashville District by Chairman Skiles.
