NOTICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE

Delegation of Authority in Notices of Contiguous Territory under Rule 1220-04-01-.13

To ensure the efficient and timely resolution of matters brought before the agency, the Tennessee Public Utility Commission takes the following administrative action:

Upon the filing of a notice of extension of service to contiguous territory consistent with Tenn. R. & Reg. 1220-04-01-.13, the filing will be referred to General Counsel or her designee as Hearing Officer for the purpose of ensuring that the filing meets the requirements of the Rule. Upon finding that all requirements have been satisfied, the Hearing Officer shall issue an *Order of Compliance and Designation of Territory* including the noticed territory to the utility's existing Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity. The findings of the Hearing Officer may be appealed to a panel of Commissioners pursuant to Tenn. R & Regs. 1220-01-02-.06(6), as appropriate. This standing delegation of authority shall continue until rescinded by the Commission.
