

2024 National Summer Transportation Host Site Application



The Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) is seeking Statement of Work (SOW) Applications for the 2024 National Summer Transportation Institute (NSTI) Program. Any accredited institution of higher education may apply to serve as a host site for this program. The length of the program must be for four (4) consecutive weeks and the overall budget should not exceed \$50,000. TDOT will consider residential, nonresidential, and hybrid programs.

The NSTI program's objectives are to improve STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) skills, provide awareness to middle and high school students (rising 9-12 graders) – particularly minority, female and disadvantaged youth – about transportation careers, and encourage participants to consider transportation-related courses of study in their pursuit of higher education. The proposal must outline how at least 20-25 students or more will be recruited and areas of involvement.
