A note will be added in the plans informing the contractor to work with utilities and railroad companies to ensure the lines are de-energized for the appropriate construction activities. The Department will work with Jackson Energy Authority to get additional details regarding timeframes and shielding options. TDOT will confirm with the railroad company regarding whether a railroad agreement will include details informing the contractor to work with the railroad for any crossings.

The Department will consider hosting a Pre-Bid Meeting for this project, specifically to discuss utility and railroad information.
