



5-Year Investment Plan

Statewide Initiatives

County	Project Description
Statewide	Statewide Interstate Truck Parking - Through resurfacing, restriping, signing, and other minor parking related improvements increase the number of truck parking spaces along the I-24, I-40, I-65, I-75, and I-81 corridors at existing truck only parking areas, rest areas, welcome centers, and weigh scale complexes throughout Tennessee.
Statewide	Statewide Weigh-in-Motion (WIM) Scales – Add mainline Weigh-in-Motion (WIM) systems (scales, cameras, over-height detection, power and internet connections, signage, etc.) upstream of all 6 existing truck weigh stations along Interstates I-24, I-40, I-65, I-75, and I-81 and at other locations throughout Tennessee.
Statewide	Conduct a study that evaluates container on barge service in the Nashville Area that reviews potential locations, markets, benefits, and economic feasibility (Container Study)
