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Tennessee Department of Transportation Partner Survey 2016

Overview and Methodology

The Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) completed its third comprehensive customer survey in 2016; the previous surveys were conducted in 2013 and 2006. A Partner Survey was not part of TDOT's initial customer survey in 2006, comparative data for only the 2013 survey is provided in this report. The purpose of the survey was to help TDOT identify and prioritize the transportation services and improvements that are most important to Tennesseans and to assess overall performance. The results of the survey will also be used to identify ways the agency can improve transportation services across the state, provide input into transportation system investments for the future, and assess changes in customer expectations and priorities from 2013.

Methodology. During the summer and fall of 2016, TDOT conducted four surveys: (1) a survey of elected officials, (2) a survey of partners, (3) a survey of residents, and (4) a benchmarking survey of residents who live in the eight states that border Tennessee. The survey of partners was designed to obtain input from non-elected representatives of organizations that "partner" with TDOT, including: city government staff, county government staff, Rural Planning Organization (RPO) staff, Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) staff, chamber officials, transit agency representatives and rail, freight, and airport officials. The survey was administered by a combination of mail, phone, and the Internet. The goal was to obtain a total of 300 completed surveys. The actual number of completed surveys was 309 with a response rate of 35% (309 of 882 responded). The overall results of the partner sample have a precision of at least +/- 5.6% at the 95% level of confidence.

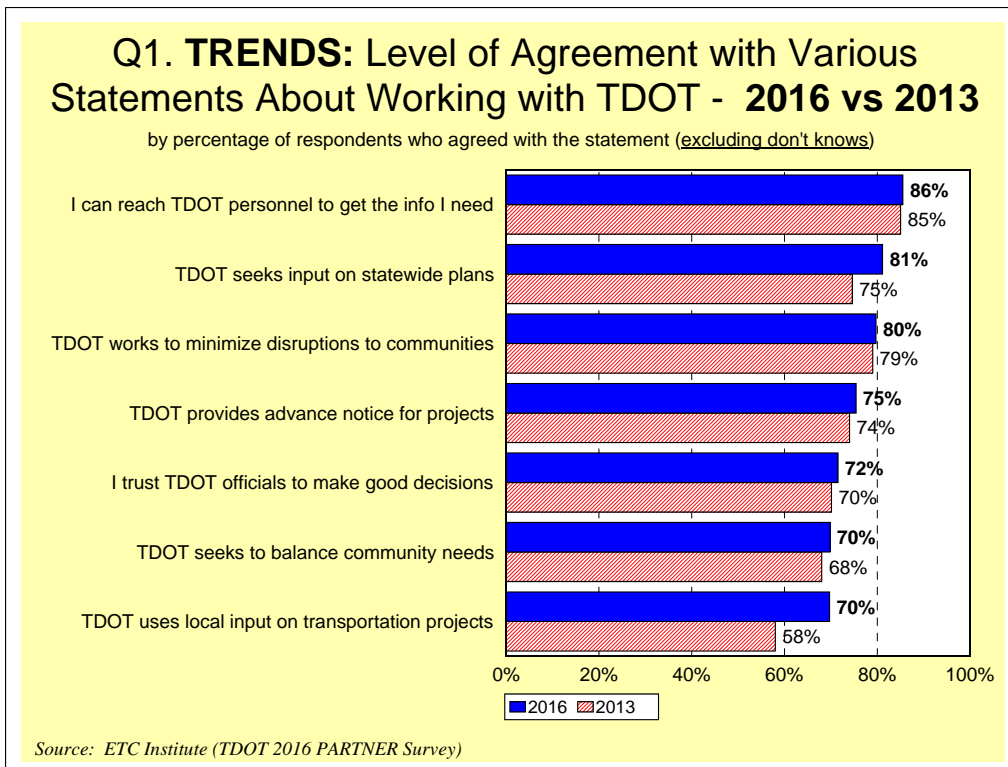
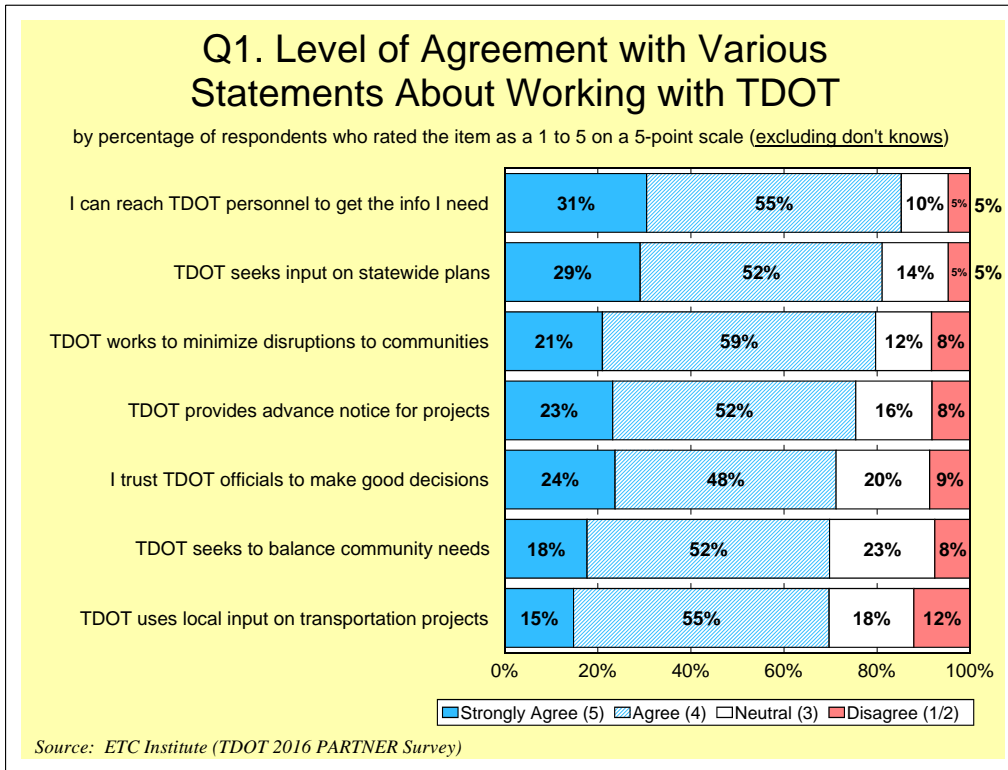

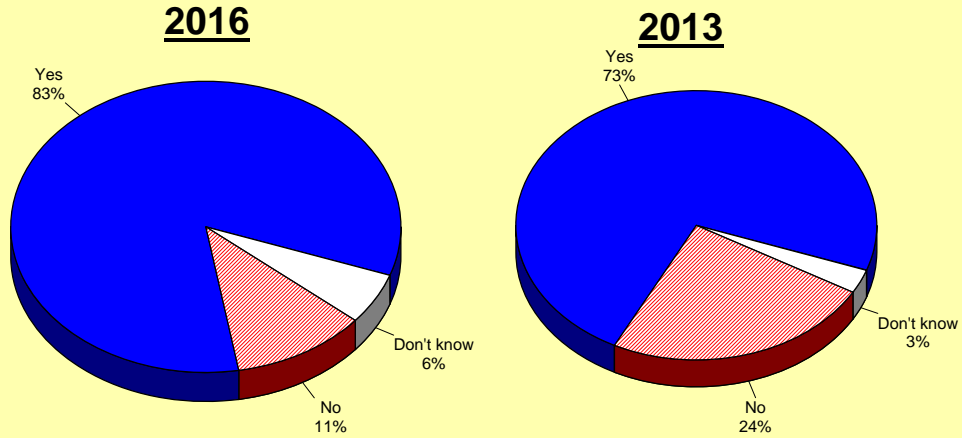

Q2. TRENDS: Has TDOT completed the construction of a new highway or the reconstruction of an existing highway in your jurisdiction during the past three years?

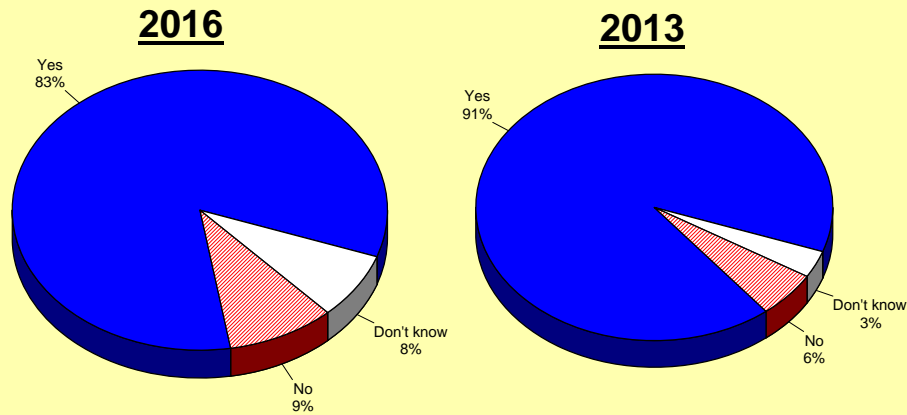
2016 vs 2013

Q2-1. TRENDS: Do you feel that the overall quality of transportation in the area has improved since the completion of this (these) project(s)? **2016 vs 2013**

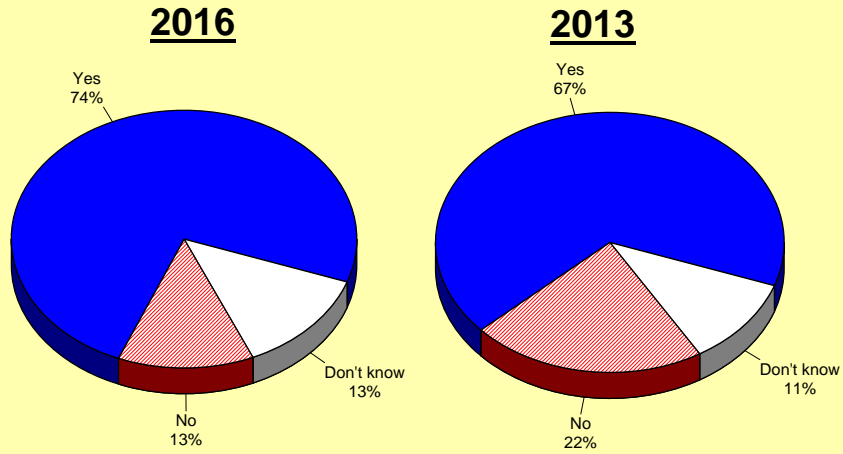
by percentage of respondents who indicated TDOT had completed a new highway or reconstruction of a highway in their area during the past three years

Q2-2. TRENDS: Do you feel that TDOT adequately involved your community during the planning of highway improvements in your area? 2016 vs 2013

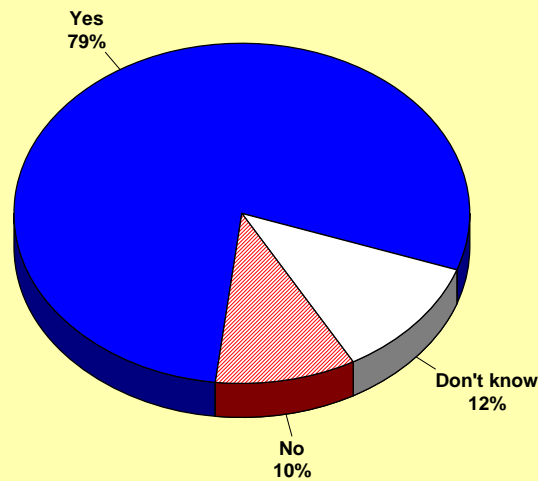
by percentage of respondents who indicated TDOT had completed a new highway or reconstruction of a highway in their area during the past three years

Q2-3. Do you feel that this (these) transportation project(s) had a positive economic impact on your community?

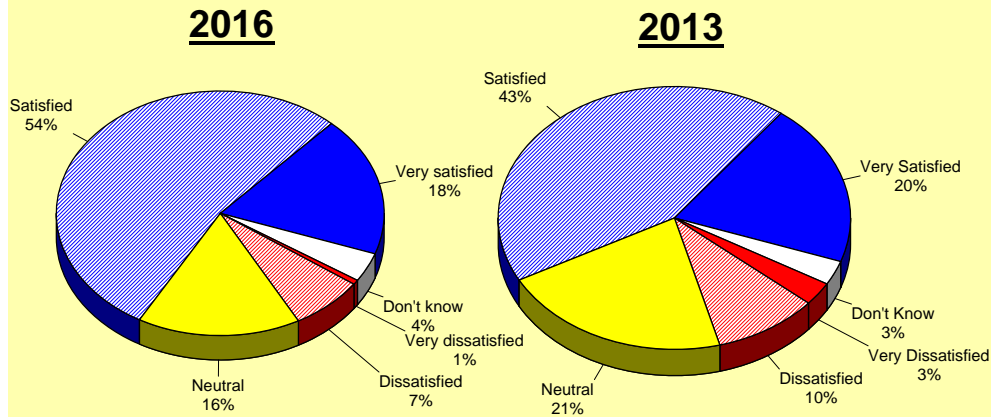
by percentage of respondents who indicated TDOT had completed a new highway or reconstruction of a highway in their area during the past three years

Q3. TRENDS: How satisfied are you with TDOT's overall efforts to keep residents informed about transportation related issues in Tennessee? **2016 vs 2013**

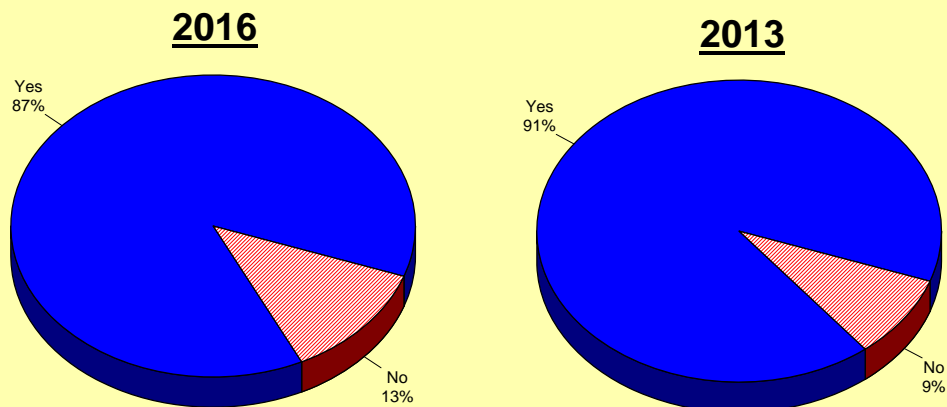
by percentage of respondents

Q4. TRENDS: Have you contacted a TDOT employee by letter, telephone, e-mail, or in person during the past two years? **2016 vs 2013**

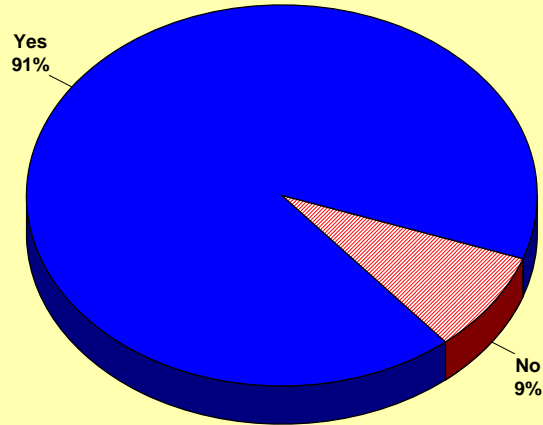
by percentage of respondents

Q4-1. If YES, did you receive a timely response to address your request or concern?

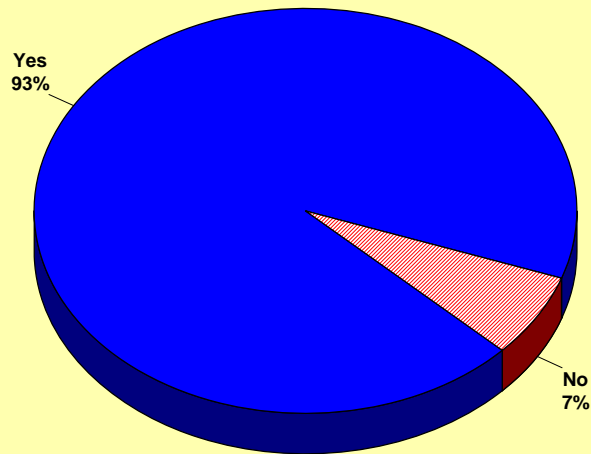
by percentage of respondents who had contacted a TDOT employee during the past two years (excluding not provided)

Q4-2. If YES, was the employee helpful?

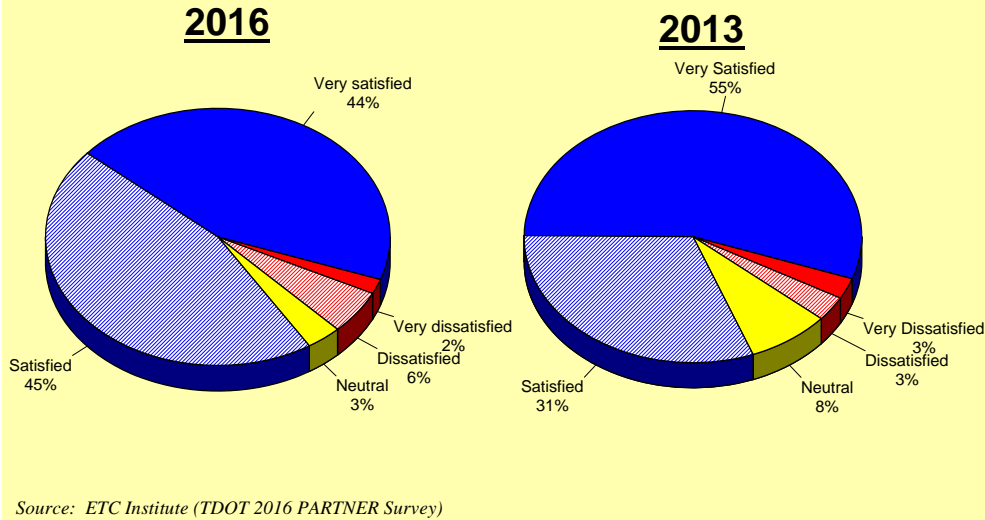
by percentage of respondents who had contacted a TDOT employee during the past two years (excluding not provided)

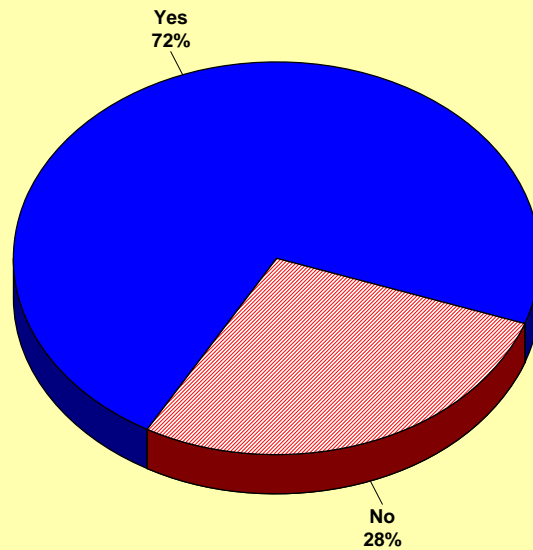
Q4-3. TRENDS: Overall, how satisfied were you with the service provided by the TDOT employee who helped you most recently? 2016 vs 2013

Q5. Have you used TDOT's web site as a source of information in the past year?

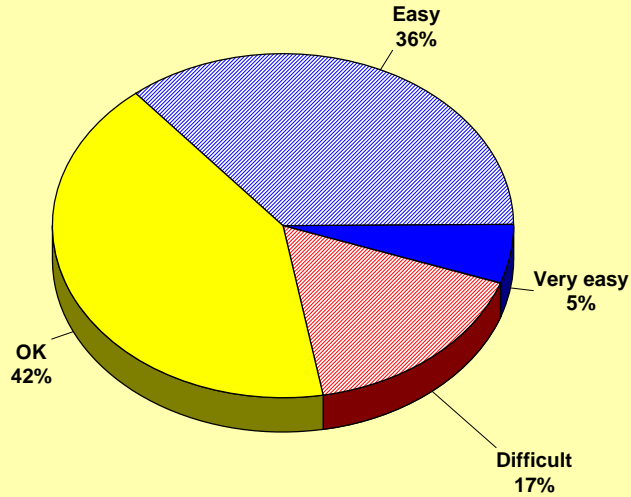
by percentage of respondents

Q5-1. If YES, how easy was it to find the information you wanted on the website?

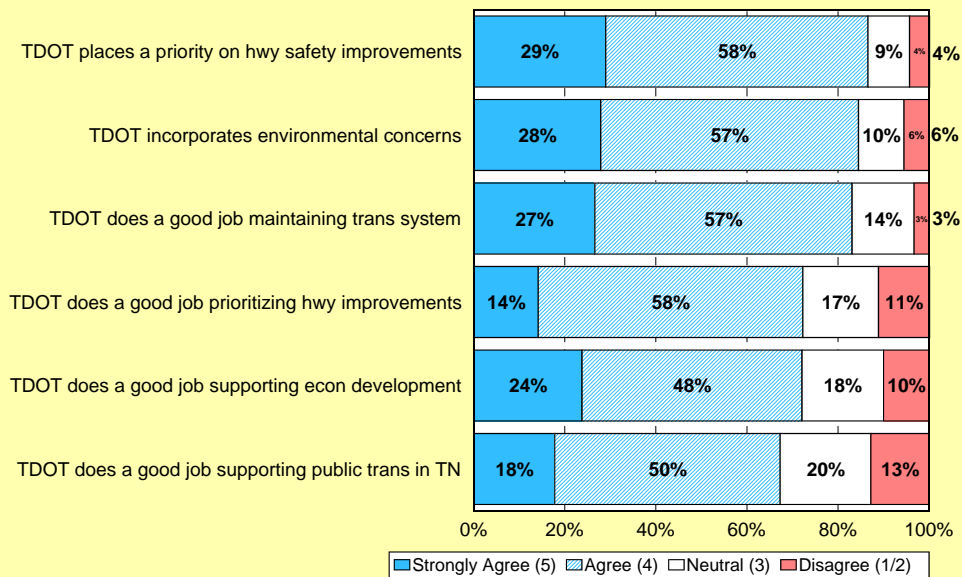
by percentage of respondents who used TDOT's web site in the past year (excluding don't knows)

Q6. Level of Agreement with Various Statements About TDOT

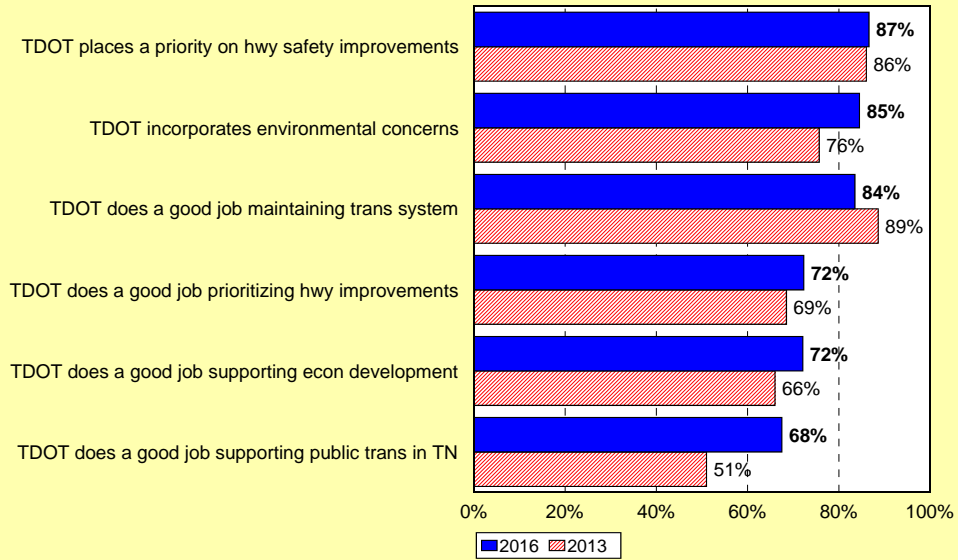
by percentage of respondents who rated the item as a 1 to 5 on a 5-point scale (excluding don't knows)

Q6. TRENDS: Level of Agreement with Various Statements About TDOT 2016 vs 2013

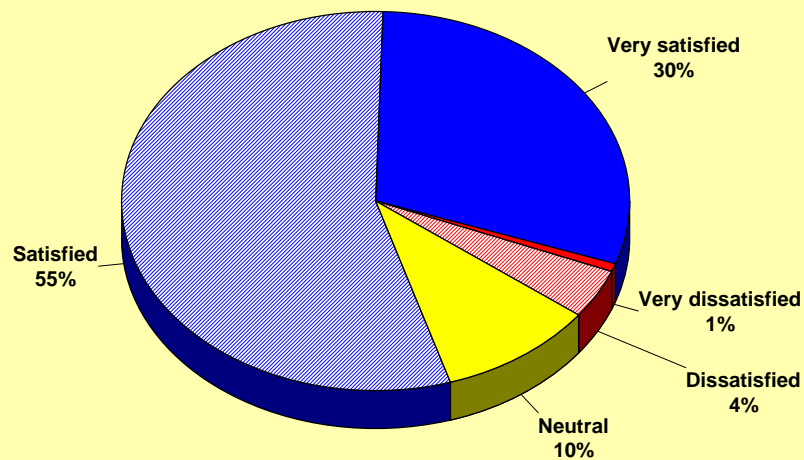
by percentage of respondents who agreed with the statement (excluding don't knows)

Q7. Overall satisfaction with the job that TDOT has done maintaining Interstate highways in Tennessee during the past two years

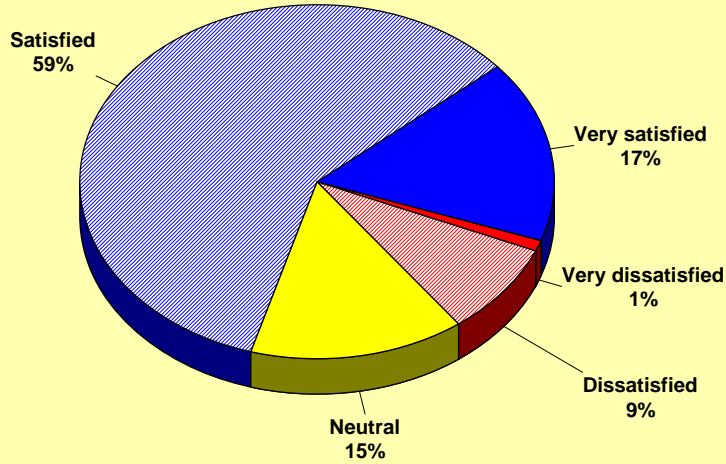
by percentage of respondents (excluding don't knows)

Q8. Overall satisfaction with the job that TDOT has done maintaining state highways other than Interstates in Tennessee during the past two years

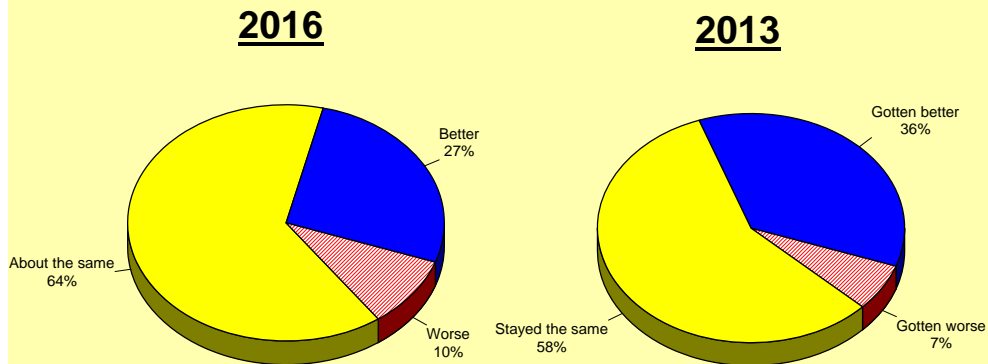

Q9. TRENDS: Compared to two years ago, how do you think that the current quality of TDOT services has changed? 2016 vs 2013

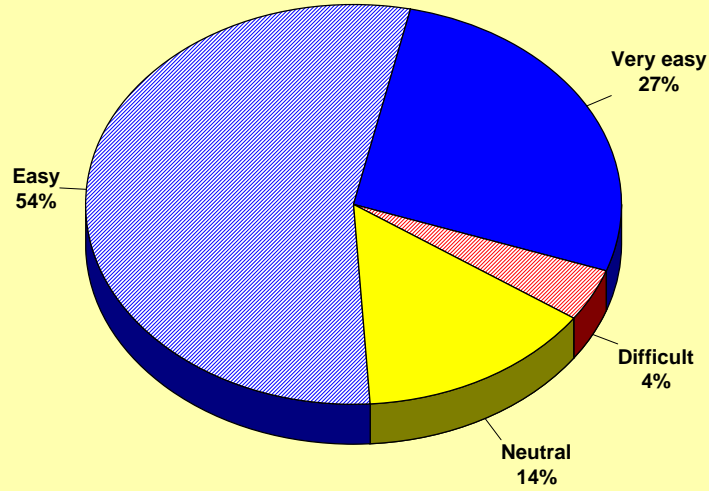

Q10. Overall, how easy do you think it is to travel between cities in Tennessee?

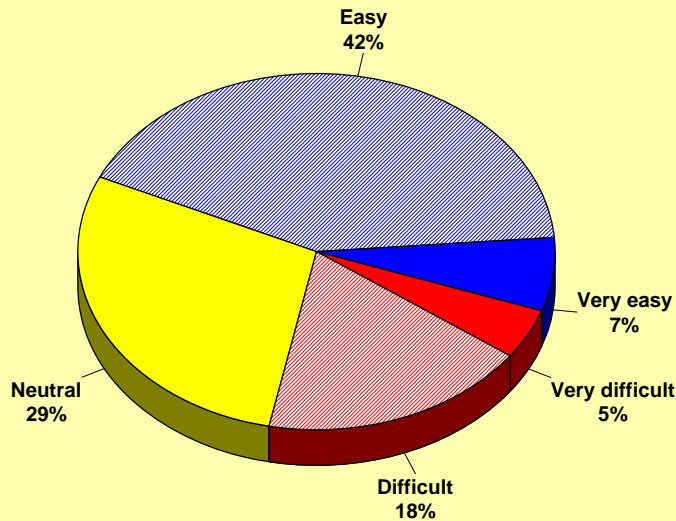
by percentage of respondents (excluding don't knows)

Q11. Overall, how easy do you think it is to travel within urban areas in Tennessee?

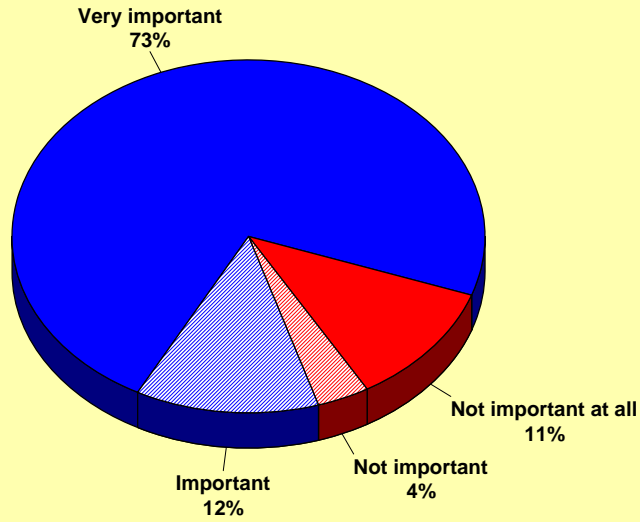
by percentage of respondents (excluding don't knows)

Q12. Thinking about your community, how important are roads, bridges, public transportation, to safety and quality of life?

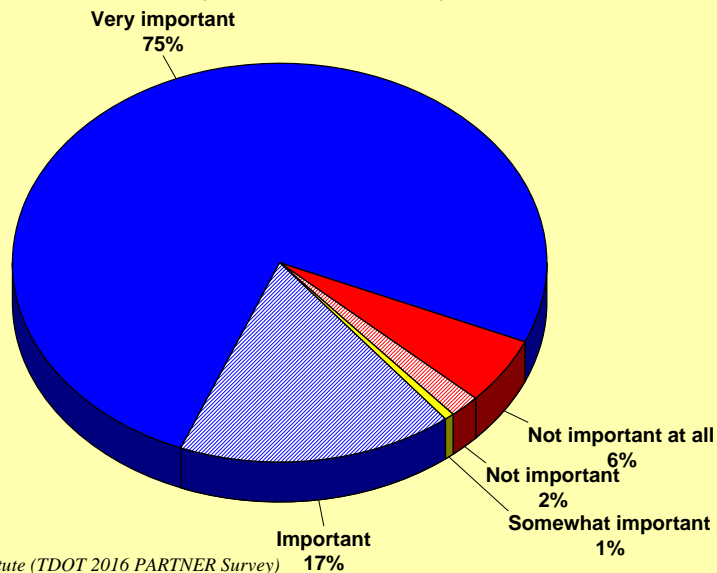
by percentage of respondents (excluding don't knows)

Q13. Thinking about your community, how important are roads, bridges, public transportation, to economic development and job growth?

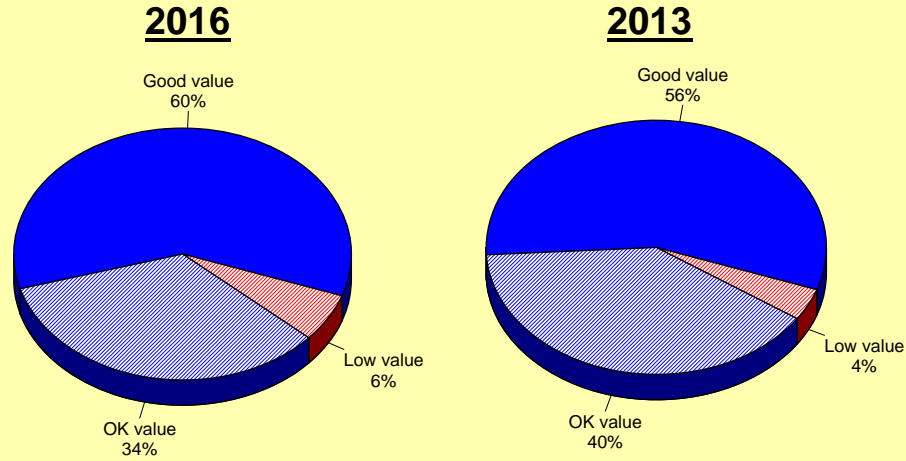
by percentage of respondents (excluding don't knows)

Q14. TRENDS: Overall, how would you rate the value provided by TDOT for the transportation taxes paid by Tennessee residents? 2016 vs 2013

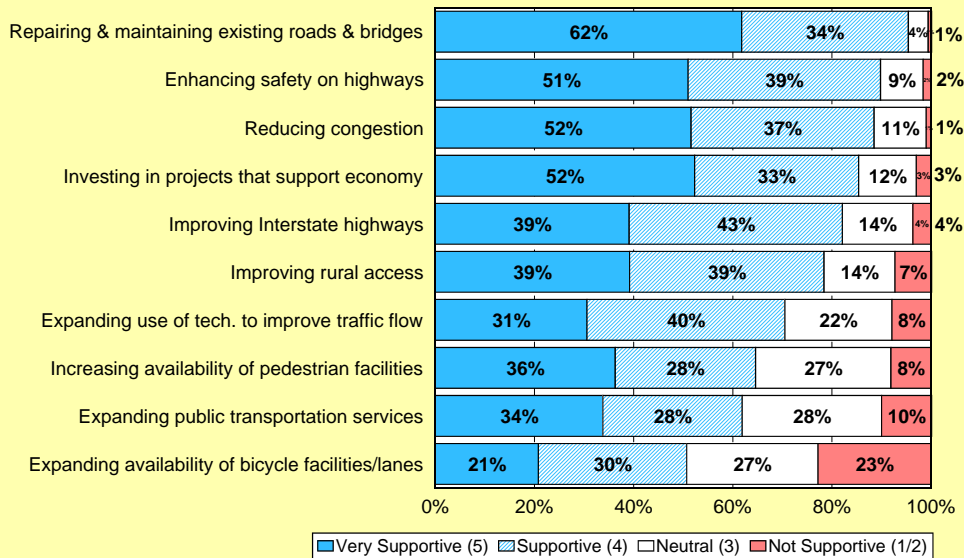
by percentage of respondents (excluding don't knows)

Q15. Level of Support for Increasing Funding for Various Transportation Improvements

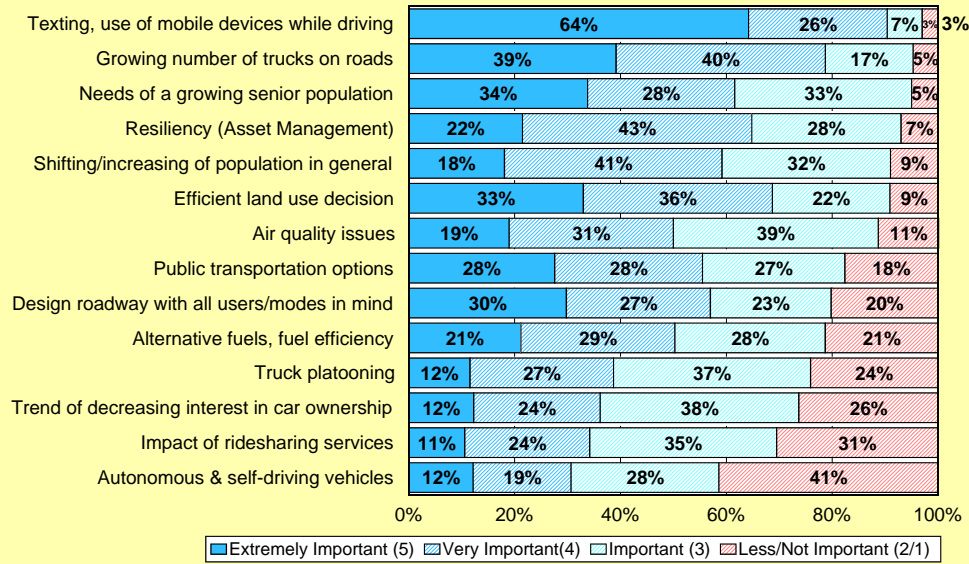
by percentage of respondents who rated the item as a 1 to 5 on a 5-point scale (excluding don't knows)

Q16. Importance of Addressing the Following National Issues Over the Next Five Years

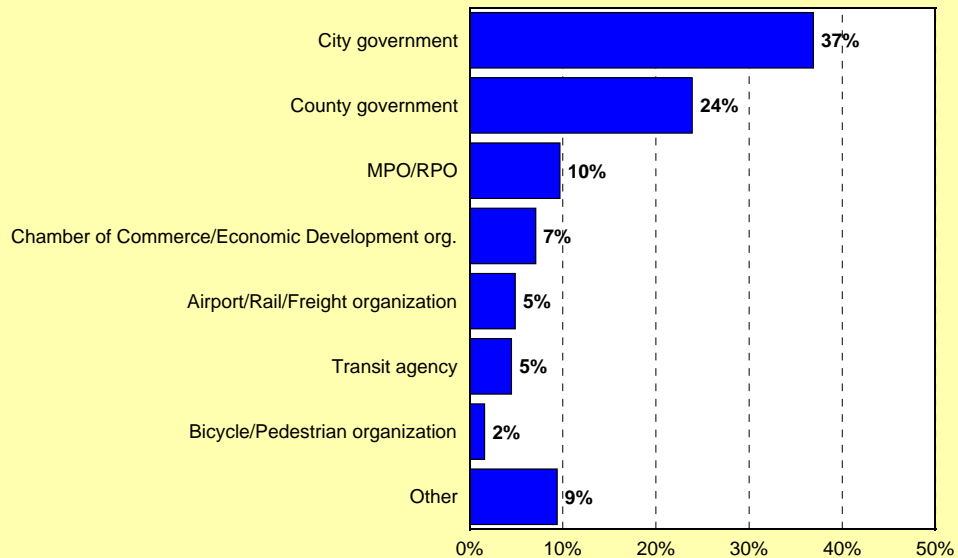
by percentage of respondents who rated the item as a 5, 4, or 3 on a 5-point scale (excluding don't knows)

Q17. Which of the following best describes your organization:

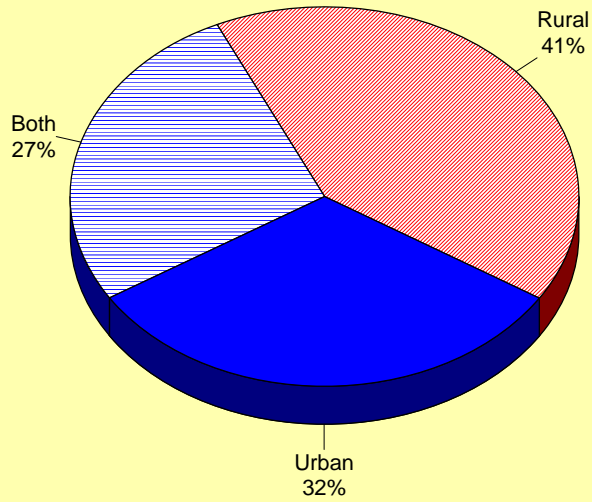
by percentage of respondents (excluding not provided)

Q18. Is the area you represent generally urban or rural?

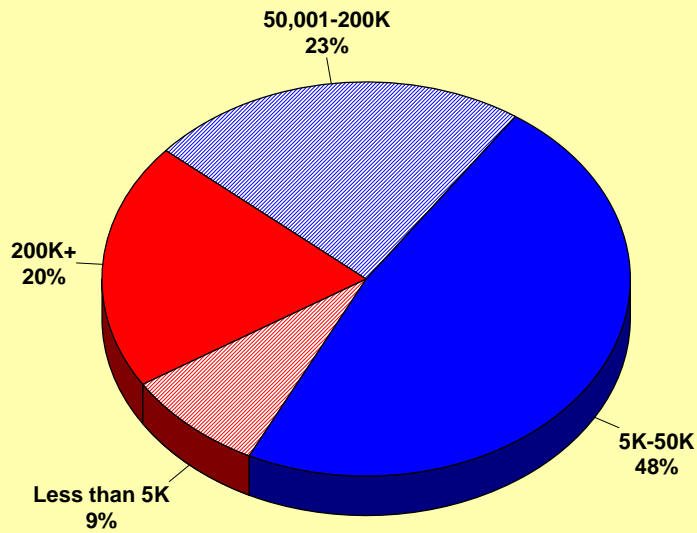
by percentage of respondents (excluding not provided)

Q19. What is the population of the city, county or geographical area that you represent?

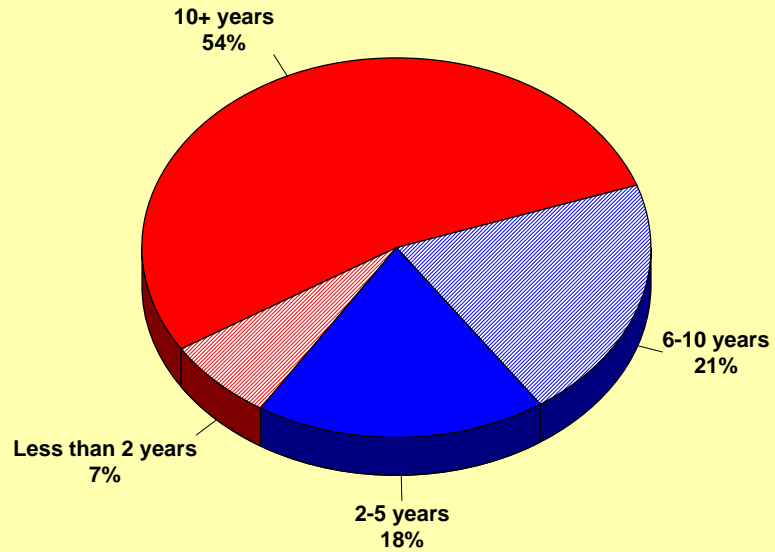
by percentage of respondents (excluding not provided)
