The classification CE is noted on licenses issued after 1992 and represents that the licensee has passed the Board licensing exam and that no county or municipality shall require such state licensee or its employees to pass any county or municipal test or examination pursuant to TCA 62-6-111(i)(2)(C).	State of Tennessee Department of Commerce & Insurance (required for jobs exceeding \$25,000)
Mechanical (CMC) (Applies if Contractor is to perform work for the HVAC Contract.)	The classification CMC is noted on licenses issued after 1992 and represents that the licensee has passed the Board licensing exam and that no county or municipality shall require such state licensee or its employees to pass any county or municipal test or examination pursuant to TCA 62-6-111(i)(2)(C). Plumbing (CMC-A) (Applies if Contractor is to perform work for the Plumbing Contract.)	The classification CMC is noted on licenses issued after 1992 and represents that the licensee has passed the Board licensing exam and that no county or municipality shall require such state licensee or its employees to pass any county or municipal test or examination pursuant to TCA 62-6-111(i)(2)(C). CMC-A applies to Plumbing and Gas Piping.	State of Tennessee Department of Commerce & Insurance (required for jobs exceeding \$25,000)
Equipment-Specific	Required by manufacturer to install and perform work on their equipment.	Manufacturer
Geothermal	Required license if performing work on the State's Geothermal systems	Various (IGSHPA, etc)
EPA Universal (Applies if Contractor is to perform work for the HVAC Contract.)	Required certification for performing maintenance, service, repair, and disposal of an appliance that contains refrigerant chemicals.	United State Environmental Protection Agency
