Separate sealed BIDS for the furnishing of all labor, materials, equipment and services for the construction of Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements for the City of Trenton, Tennessee will be received by the City of Trenton until 2:00 P.M., Local Time on June 8, 2016 at Trenton Light and Water Department, 109 West Armory Drive, Trenton, TN 38382 at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids for this project being delivered via the U.S. Postal Service or shipped via a parcel delivery service should be addressed to Mr. Scott Dahlstrom, General Manager, Trenton Light and Water Department, and the Bidder shall be responsible for their early delivery. Bids delivered using the U. S. Postal Service or a parcel delivery service must be labeled on the envelope used for shipping "Bid Enclosed" and an inside sealed envelope with all required information described hereinafter listed on its exterior shall be utilized to package the Bid.

Contract 16-1: Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements includes the following major items and all necessary appurtenances:

- Renovation of the existing influent sewage pumping station;
- Miscellaneous site improvements.

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Attention of Bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under this Contract, Section 3, segregated facility, Section 109 and E.O. 11246.

All bidders must be licensed general contractors as required by Title 62, Chapter 6 of the Contractors Licensing Act of 1994 of the State of Tennessee, as amended, and qualified for the type of construction for which bids are solicited. **For all bids in excess of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000), each bidder submitting a bid as the prime contractor shall write on the outside of the envelope containing the bid the bidder's name, the bidder's Contractor's license number, the expiration date of the bidder's Contractor's license, and that part of the classification applying to this bid. When the bid for the prime contract is less than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000), the name of the bidder submitting a bid as the prime Contractor only may appear on the outside of the envelope containing the bid and upon opening the envelope, if such bid is in excess of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) the same shall be automatically disqualified. Failure of any bidder to comply therewith shall void such bid and the envelope containing such bid shall not be opened or considered. It is the duty and responsibility of the awarding person or entity who received the envelope containing the bid to verify only the completeness of the required licensure information prior to opening of the envelope. Prior to opening of the envelope, the names of all contractors listed thereon shall be read aloud at the official bid opening and incorporated into the bid.**

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all Bids, to waive informalities, and to negotiate with the apparent qualified best bidder or bidders to such extent as may be necessary.

No Bidder may withdraw his Bid within 60 days after the date of the bid opening. Mutually agreed upon extensions of time may be made if necessary.

Bids shall be accompanied by a certified check or Bid Bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the Bid to insure the execution of the Contract for which such Bid is made. In case the Bid is not accepted, the check or Bid Bond will be returned to the Bidder, but if the Bid is accepted and the Bidder shall refuse or neglect to enter into a Contract with the City of Trenton, Tennessee within ten (10) days from the time he shall be notified of the acceptance of this Bid, the said check or Bid Bond shall be forfeited to the City of Trenton, Tennessee as liquidated damages for the failure to do so.

The successful Bidder shall be required to furnish both an acceptable Performance Bond and Payment Bond each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract price from a surety company listed on the most recent edition of U.S. Treasury Department Circular 570.

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Liquidated damages in the amounts set out in the Contract Documents and Detailed Specifications may be assessed for failure to complete work within the Contract completion time as specified therein.
