Update on the Tennessee Health Care Innovation Initiative

- *Primary Care Transformation Consultants*
 - McKinsey Consulting has signed a contract with the State to serve as our consultants for primary care transformation.
 - McKinsey will assist in the design, implementation and support of two programs: (1) a Patient-Centered Medical Homes (PCMH) program for commercial and Medicaid insurance, and (2) Medicaid Health Homes for TennCare members with severe and persistent mental illness.

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- The May reports for perinatal, acute asthma exacerbation and total joint replacement have been released by all TennCare Managed Care Organizations (MCOs). Some commercial payers are sending informational reports as well. These reports include data on episodes ending between January 2014 and December 2014.
- The first preview reports for the next five episodes have also been released, including [screening and surveillance colonoscopy](#), [acute PCI](#), [non-acute PCI](#), [outpatient and non-acute inpatient cholecystectomy](#), and [acute COPD exacerbation](#). These preview reports also include data on episodes ending between January 2014 and December 2014. Over 1,000 preview reports were released to over 440 unique quarterbacks.
- Both the preview and performance period reports include new information added at the request of providers. The reports now include patient's date of birth and sorting of episodes by rendering provider, where applicable.
