Article III - 320 of the International Registration Plan

The chart is based on an average per-vehicle distance per Member Jurisdiction by:

1. Determining the total actual distances reported to Tennessee as having been operated in each Member Jurisdiction by Fleets for which Tennessee served as the Base Jurisdiction during the previous Registration Year;
2. Determining the number of Apportioned Vehicles for which Tennessee served as the Base Jurisdiction during the previous Registration Year that accrued distance in each respective Member Jurisdiction; and
3. For each Member Jurisdiction dividing the distance determined by the number of Apportioned Vehicles.
