## 2013 LABOR DAY HOLIDAY

FRIDAY, AUGUST 30 - MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 2  
96-HOUR HOLIDAY PERIOD

- **FATAL CRASHES:** 15

Twelve crashes were single vehicle crashes; three were multiple vehicle crashes.

- **FATALITIES:** 16

Six (38%) of the fatalities occurred in alcohol-related crashes.

Ten (63%) of the people killed were vehicle occupants.

Six of the ten (60%) were not wearing safety restraints.

Four motorcyclists were killed, and all were wearing helmets.

One ATV rider was killed and was not wearing a helmet.

One pedestrian was killed.
