## Aventail No Longer Required to Access TnCOP

The enhancement to simplify access to the Fusion System/CRMS has been completed. You are no longer required to use the Aventail VPN to access the CRMS. Please use the following instructions to log onto the Fusion System/TnCOP application using the new method:

1. Open your Internet browser
2. Type the following URL into the address bar: <https://www.tfc.tn.gov/leadr/login.jsp>
3. Press Enter—This will present the CRMS Login screen.
4. Log in as you normally would using your ORI, Username and Password.



While you are no longer required to use the Aventail VPN, that method of access is still operational should you find the new method is unusable for your particular environment.

# Trouble Viewing TnCrimeOnline Reports with Internet Explorer 10



We have had several agencies reporting issues viewing TnCrimeOnline reports when using the Internet Explorer 10 web browser.

**THE PROBLEM:** → → →

The screenshot provided to the right is an example of a TnCrimeOnline report with IE 10. The various TIBRS data elements listed on the left are cut off and difficult to view.


**THE SOLUTION:** → → ↓ ↓

Agencies utilizing IE 10 must click the compatibility view button at the top of the webpage to be able to see the entire screen.



Using Internet Explorer 10 in compatibility mode should resolve the issue, and allow you to view TnCrimeOnline reports with the TIBRS data elements being fully visible on the left side of the page as seen in the screenshot to the right.

## 2013 TIBRS Conference Details

### **CONFERENCE REGISTRATION**

The 2013 TIBRS Conference will return to the Music Road Inn and Conference Center in Pigeon Forge, TN. This year the conference dates are September 16th through the 18th. All agencies wishing to send attendees to the conference are asked to complete registration prior to the conference. Online registration for the TIBRS 2013 Conference is now open! Early Registration ends August 30, 2013; registration and/or payment must be post-marked by this date in order to qualify for the early conference fee amount of \$105 per person. Any registration submitted after the given deadline will be subject to the late registration fee amount of \$140 per person. The very last day to cancel registration and receive a full refund is September 6, 2013; cancellations after this date will be subject to no refund. A complete conference packet has been sent to all agencies detailing this information.
