Should the CGP expiration date (May 23, 2016) be listed for all Level 2 certifications?</p>	<p>No certification number is given on the Level 2 website. For those that are grandfathered in under the old Level 2, list the CGP expiration date as the expiration date for the Level 2 certification. Please make a note of anyone that does not show up on the Level 2 website certification listing that is grandfathered. For those that have taken the class more recently, list the expiration date on the website/given at time of passage of Level 2 test.</p>
<p>For the Environmental Permitting proposal, in the supplement questions document, Item #3. Experience – It mentions including resumes in the appendix, limited to 2 pages. Are these resumes in addition to the resumes already included in Section E of the DT-0330 document?</p>	<p>Yes, these are. Please include them again in the Appendix.</p>

Given the broad spectrum of “environmental construction inspection work”, we respectfully request additional clarification be provided as to what types of services would be considered under this heading.</p>	<p>All of the above. It can include EPSC inspections, or wetland and stream mitigation construction site inspections. The environmental construction inspection work should be relevant to the contract you are pursuing.</p>
