
Thank you for attending the Design Public Meeting for the proposed widening of SR-268 (Thompson Lane) from SR-1 (Broad Street) to SR-10 (Memorial Boulevard). The proposed improvements include upgrading from an existing two-lane roadway section to a five-lane roadway section with additional turning lanes, intersection improvements, shoulders, curb & gutter, and sidewalks. In total, the improvements include roughly 4.3 miles of roadway construction work.

These improvements are intended to address congestion, improve safety, and accommodate area growth. These improvements will also help traffic near the Siegel schools, not only due to an improved five-lane roadway section, but also with the addition of turning lanes into each school entrance.



