Certification Requirements

To be issued certification as a Hazardous Materials Operations Level, the candidate will:

Show successful completion of the above pre-requisite requirement. This must be documented on file at the Tennessee Commission on Firefighting.

Written Examination

- Perform to a minimum 70% competency on a 100-question examination for Hazardous Materials Operations.
 - Retest after 15 days and must be passed within one year of passing the practical exam is allowed.

Practical Examination

 Successfully complete skills evaluation(s) (3 skill sheets randomly selected by the TFFC), to a minimum of 70% competency and successful completion of all critical points.

Practical Examination for Certification: Skills testing will be conducted using a minimum of 1 skill from chapter 5 and 2 skills from chapter 6 of the JPRs listed below. The skills will be randomly drawn by the TFFC Coordinator and administered by an approved evaluator after all training hours have been completed. For successful completion of the practical examination, a minimum 70% competency (including critical points) is required for certification. Please refer to the Certification Criteria for this level for a complete listing of the certification requirements.
