   participate by electronic or other means of
 3 communication, the governing body must make a
 4 determination that a necessity exists. That
 5 determination must include a recitation of the facts and
   circumstances on which it is based.

                    Further, Tennessee Code
 8 Annotated 8-44-108(a)(3) defines "necessity" as matters
   to be considered by the governing body at that meeting
   require timely action by the body, that physical

   presence by a quorum of the members is not practical

   within the period of time requiring action, and that

   participation by a quorum of the members by electronic
   or other means of communication is necessary.
